MEMBERSHIP DESCRIPTIONS

Full Membership: Includes skater and parent US membership for one-year. Full US testing membership for the skater, voting eligibility for the parent, Board of Directors eligibility for the parent. Skater may participate in all competitions representing WWFSC, the holiday exhibition and the annual ice show. Skater must skate at least 1-hour/week at Mike Modano Ice Arena while the arena is open for the parent/guardian to remain eligible to vote and serve on the Board of Directors.

Additional/subsequent Skater Membership: Includes additional skater(s) residing at the same address as parent and skater who have a full membership. Skater privileges are the same as those of the first skater listed under Full Membership.

Introductory Membership: One-time only skater US membership for one-year. Full US testing membership for the skater, voting eligibility for the parent. Skater may participate in all competitions representing WWFSC, the holiday exhibition, and the annual ice show. Skater must skate at least 1-hour/week at Mike Modano Ice Arena while the arena is open for the parent/guardian to remain eligible to vote in the annual election of the Board of Directors.

Basic Club Membership: Includes skater Basic Club Membership for one year. **This is not a testing membership**. Skater may participate in all competitions representing WWFSC, the holiday exhibition, and the annual ice show. *Skaters (LTS) must complete their own membership registration at learntoskateusa.com.* The \$30 fee is for membership in the WWFSC and is separate from LTS membership with Learn to Skate USA.

Coaching Membership: Includes full US membership for one year, voting and Board of Directors eligibility. **This is not a testing membership**.

Collegiate Membership: Includes full US testing membership for four-years, voting and Board of Directors eligibility. Skater may participate in all competitions representing WWFSC, the holiday exhibition, and the annual ice show.

Adult Skating Membership: Includes full US testing membership for one year, voting and Board of Directors eligibility. Skater may participate in all competitions representing WWFSC, the holiday exhibition, and the annual ice show.

Second Club Membership: Includes second club membership for one year. **This is not a testing membership.** Skater may participate in the holiday exhibition and the annual ice show. Not eligible for voting or Board of Directors.

PARENT AND SKATER BEHAVIOR The Wayne-Westland Figure Skating Club has zero tolerance for parent or skater misconduct. Inappropriate language, social media posts or creating an environment of hostility will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the club and club activities without a refund of previously paid fees. Please refer to the USFS parent and skater Code of Ethics for full details (Club Bylaws and copies of the USFS 'Code of Ethics" will be available on the club's website at www.wwfsc.org

VOLUNTEERING You must volunteer at least one (1) shift at our USFS home competition. There is a \$100 fee for non-compliance. Participation in the annual ice show is not required for club membership but it is encouraged and additional volunteer hours must be completed; please see ice show contract for details and obligations.

COMMITTEES There are many committees needed to make the WWFSC run smoothly. The Board of Directors invite and encourage all parents to participate in available committees either as a Committee Chair or a committee member. BOARD MEETINGS The WWFSC Board of Directors meet virtually the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7pm. Meetings are held from September-May; June-August the schedule and location varies. The board meetings are open to all members and parents are encouraged to attend as many as they would like. If there is something that needs to be discussed with the board, email the President of the club at least three (3) days prior to the meeting and he/she will add the item(s) to the agenda. WWFSC is requesting each family attend at least one (1) board meeting/season (in-person or through Zoom) to stay informed and participate in club business. The Board of Directors is re-elected each spring.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of the opportunity to participate in U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned events and activities during the 2025-26 U.S. Figure Skating Competition Season ("Events and Activities"), the undersigned, individually, and on behalf of his/her heirs, personal representatives, administrators, agents, successors and assigns (collectively referred to herein as "Participant"), AGREES TO ASSUME THE RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY, TO RELEASE AND TO INDEMNIFY U.S. Figure Skating, its directors, officers, members, employees, officials, committees, volunteers, clubs, affiliates, sponsors, representatives, agents, successors and assigns, including the host club, local organizing committee and any other entity responsible for the hosting and/or conduct of the Events and Activities (collectively referred to herein as "U.S. Figure Skating"), as follows:

- 1. Assumption of Risk and Responsibility. Participant fully understands and appreciates the risks of injury that may occur in ice skating or in the course of preparing for, participating in and traveling to or from the Events and Activities. The risks of injury that may occur include, but are not limited to, the risk of, serious bodily injury, viral infections, bacterial infections and risk of other communicable diseases and illness, permanent disability, paralysis and death (collectively referred to herein as "Risks"). Participant acknowledges that Participant voluntarily engages in such Events and Activities with adequate knowledge of such Risks; and agrees that Participant fully assumes all such Risks and all legal and financial responsibility for (a) any and all injuries or damages, whether to person or property, that Participant may in any manner sustain in connection therewith or in the conduct and management of the Events and Activities, including such injury or damage that may result from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause and (b) all treatment, hospitalization and other care rendered to Participant in the event of Participant's illness, injury or other emergency circumstance in connection with participation in the Events and Activities, subject to any applicable insurance coverage.
- 2. Release and Indemnification. Participant hereby fully and forever releases, discharges, holds harmless, and agrees to indemnify U.S. Figure Skating from and against any and all liabilities, claims, demands, lawsuits, damages, and judgments, present or future, known or unknown, valid or invalid, direct or consequential, together with reasonable costs and attorneys' fees, which result directly or indirectly from damages, losses, injuries or death to Participant, Participant's property, other persons or property incurred during or in connection with any activities associated with or being a part of the Events and Activities and the conduct and management thereof, including any participation, travel or medical treatment, hospitalization or other care rendered in connection with the Events and Activities, whether such loss, damage, injury or death results from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause.

I HAVE READ THIS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I AND THE MINOR HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE. I INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THAT THE REMAINING PROVISIONS SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

The undersigned provides this Authorization and Consent for Emergency Medical Care in consideration of the opportunity to participate in U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned events and activities during the 2025-26 U.S. Figure Skating Competition Season ("Events and Activities").

In the event of illness, injury or medical or other emergency circumstances while participating in any of the Events and Activities, and if I am disabled or incompetent to make appropriate decisions concerning treatment thereof (and in the case that participant is a minor and minor's parent or legal guardian cannot be timely contacted to participate in the making of necessary decisions), I, the participant, or if participant is a minor, I as the parent/guardian of said participant, give my consent to U.S. Figure Skating, its agents, officials, employees, volunteers, clubs, instructors, and trainers, and the agents, officials, employees, volunteers, instructors, and trainers at the facility where any of the Events and Activities are taking place, to obtain emergency medical care from any Licensed Medical Professional, hospital or clinic, including transportation and emergency medical service for myself/ourselves and/or said participant for any injury or illness that could arise from participation in the Events and Activities.

I further authorize and consent to the release of any pertinent medical information and records regarding my treatment, diagnosis and/or examination to the U.S. Figure Skating Sports Medicine Committee and the Medical Committee Staff of the Events and Activities in which I am participating.
