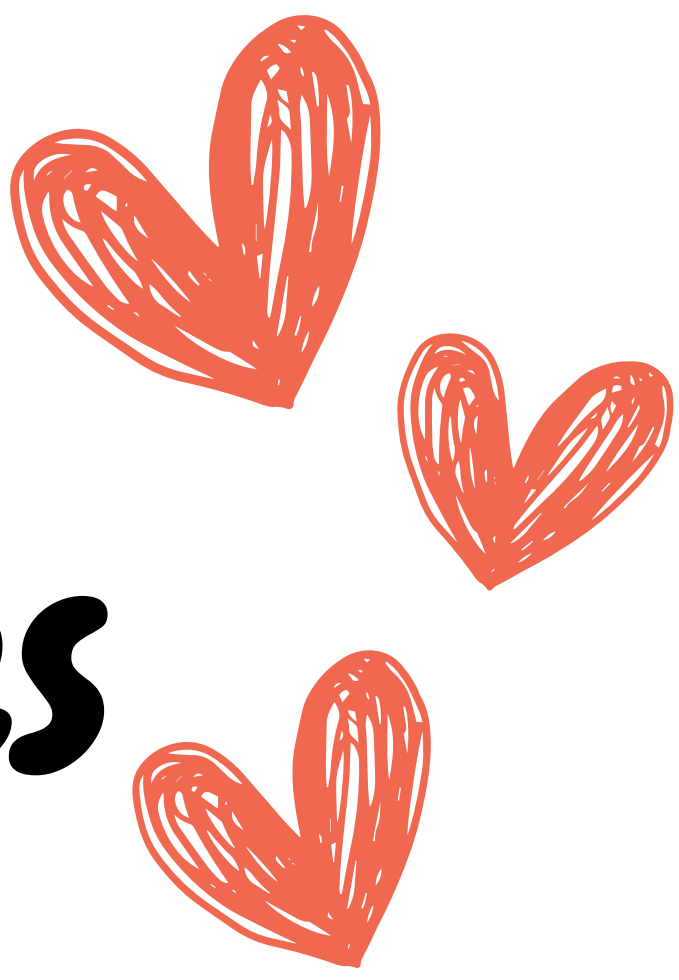

Ways You Can Care 4 All Creatures

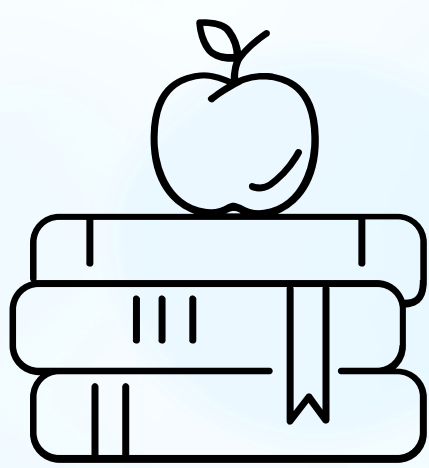


Care changes the world one small act at a time.



AT HOME

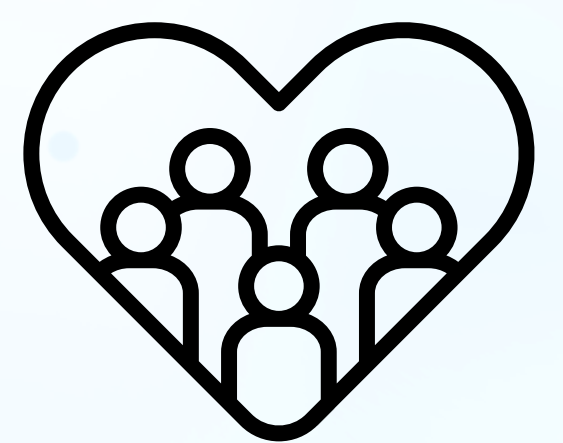
- Take great care of your pets every day.
- Spay or neuter your pets.
- Be kind to all animals outside your home.
- Don't bother wild animals—including our smallest friends— bees and ants.
- If you see a wild animal that needs help, call local rescue.
- Help non-dangerous small creatures, like an insect upside down or trapped. If they can sting or bite, ask an adult to help.
- If there are stray cats or dogs in your neighborhood, call your local shelter to get help.



AT SCHOOL

- Share your love of animals with others.
- If you see anyone being mean to or hurting an animal, say something to them and get help from an adult.
- If you have a classroom animal, be a leader to make sure it is happy and taken care of daily.
- Share ways your friends can get involved to care for animals and invite them to join you.
- Organize a donation drive with your teacher to get food and supplies for animal shelters.

- Ask animal organizations how you can help.
- If you are too young to volunteer, find out what supplies are needed for animals.
- 'Like' these organizations on social media and share with others to get animals adopted and share supply needs
- See if your family can foster or sponsor a pet.
- If you see an animal in need, get an adult to help.
- Be loud and proud about caring for all creatures!
