Introduction

Shawna calls meeting to order at 5:40pm approx.

PTO Business

- Coronavirus and impact on field trips, dance, sports in light of 3/9/20 letter from Superintendent
 - Mr. Barnes said he made a list of non essential meetings that can be cut now, where there are a bunch of people gathered together. Could be games, sports, practice, social activities. It's still being figured out now. It will be determined and we will wait to hear. Dance may be cancelled.
- Erin/Shawna update on Cunha Teacher Supply Drive--about 15 teachers still have items left to purchase. Link here: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/20f0a4daea822a5fa7-show
 - Was very successful, 15 teachers still have items on their lists.
 - Ruth Wolk said the supply drive was so great and said they are using all the supplies. She is very appreciative.
- Report from Coastside PTO Alliance (Shawna):
 - All PTO leaders meet. HMBHS does not pay librarian. EG pays only 4 hours per week. We pay 2 hours per day. B&GC will be fundraising for sports. There was a 200-300k cut, what was it for. Mr Barnes said district has no interest in paying for sports at all. B&GC have fundraising to help our sports at Cunha. Sports will hopefully remain, just under B&GC. School wants kids to participate regardless of their ability to pay for sports. Boosters give money to the district. B&GC will raise the money. Mr. Barnes said there is a link for people to donate. 100K donation from B&GC to help keep sports going. Mr. Barnes is going to put a letter out to tell people about Coastside Gives & B&GC donations. Are we going to continue to have multiple ways and places to donate or come together somehow. Should we change our coastside gives goal? Mr Cox says there use to be assemblies for kids who didn't get in trouble. Bringing in speakers and assemblies to help keep them on track, could be run by PTO or leadership. Libby & Erin will talk about Coastside Gives.



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- Status of PE Depts \$2k from sale of required PE clothing (shirts \$13 and shorts \$15) and locks \$7--that's \$35 per student. If half of student body buys one set, that's about \$13,125 (375 x \$35) Has this been re-negotiated between CAB and Administration yet?
 - PE and boosters re-negotiated money from PE sales so PE will get to keep the funds raised
- Tom Cox talk Dances and what the \$2,500 ASB grant covers. Next year move to submit receipts for consistency with other departments and for tax purposes to protect our non-profit status in case of audit
 - Mr Cox said leadership keeps money from pizza and photos, and PTO gives them \$2500. If PTO wants to take back pizza and photo leadership is ok with that.
- **Tentative 2020-2021 Budget** at May, 2020 meeting--let's be thinking about what worked this year, what didn't and what we may want to change for next school year over the next two months.
 - Budget for next year needs to be started and approved
- Teacher / Parent Survey (Erin/Communications Director)
 - Erin is thinking about a survey from teachers regarding what they think is good to fund, projects,
 etc. What would you like PTO to help teachers with.
 - One to teachers, one to parents. Questions about fundraising, support, etc. Scale of importance for what PTO should focus on. ELAC face to face to reach Spanish speaking families. Erin will put survey out through google and possibly print for the Spanish speaking families. Mr. Barnes said parents could use Chrome books, meeting is next Tuesday.

Treasurer Report (Elizabeth)

- Review financials, what spent, what hasn't
 - No additional spending approved
 - No motions to approve \$1,600 for purchase of 6&7 min mile shirts for PE/Longaker
 - No motions to approve re-purposing unspent funds / approve up to \$150 for 15 teachers who have items left on wish list for a maximum of \$2,250

- Stephanie Izarelli, CEF Innovation Grants
