The event occurred on 01/17/2025 at approximately 23:50 at 3916 SOUTH CAPITOL STREET SE, WASHINGTON, DC 20032.

On January 17, 2025 at 2048 hours ShotSpotter alerted to (3) gunshots at 3913 South Capitol Street Southwest and (4) gunshots at 3920 South Capitol Street Southeast. While units were canvassing, Office of Unified Communications Center dispatched a radio run for a shooting victim located at 3836 South Capitol Street Southeast. Officers made contact with a male victim who verbally identified himself as Saamir Ali (unverified) who was suffering from a gunshot wound to his hand and leg. After further investigation, Mr.Ali's real name is King, Delvon B/M DOB 1/21/1989 and will be hereafter referred to as Def.King.

Def.King stated that he was walking on South Capitol Street Southeast and heard gunshots and realized that he was shot. DCFEMS responded to the scene and transported Def.King to George Washington University Hospital for treatment.

A crime scene was located in the 3800 and 3900 block of South Capitol Street Southeast with multiple cartridge casings in different locations and trail of apparent blood droppings. The droppings were observed on the east sidewalk of the 3800 block of South Capitol Street Southeast and followed to 3836 South Capitol Street Southeast into the building and up the steps towards the 3rd floor where he was located. A request was made for a Detective and Detective Samuels responded to assume the investigative responsibilities. The female caller was interviewed and she stated that Def.King knocked on her apartment door and advised that he was shot. The female caller provided aid and called 911. W-1, who is WMATA bus driver, was located and W-1 stated that while the bus was parked, IT heard gunshots and a bullet struck the front windshield. W-1 observed several vehicles fleeing the parking lot of 3916 South Capitol Street Southeast but W-1 did not observe who was shooting.

Detective Samuels observed the crime scene and (3) cartridge casings were located in the parking lot of 3916 South Capitol Street Southeast and (5) cartridge casings were located in a grassy area adjacent to the entrance of the parking lot. There were (2) cartridge casings located on the east sidewalk of the 3900 block of South Capitol Street Southeast, (11) cartridge casings on the sidewalk in front of the parking lot of 3850 South Capitol Street Southeast and (3) cartridge casings in the 7 Eleven parking lot at 3900 Martin Luther King Jr Avenue Southwest. Multiple CCTV footage was recovered by Detective Samuels.

During his treatment he was found to be in possession of multiple narcotics. Def.King had 147 blue pills that were not inside of a pill bottle, but wrapped in plastic. The listed blue pills had the markings of the letter "M" on one side and the number "30" on the other. Officers utilized the website drugs.com and it stated that the markings and color of the pills are Oxycodone. Def.King was also in possession of several white rock like substances. The white rock substance was field tested by Officer

Azzam and it yielded a positive color reaction for cocaine base. Def.King was in possession of brown rock like substances. Officer Azzam field tested those and it yielded a positive color reaction for amphetamines/meth.

Due to the amount of the listed narcotics and the way it was packaged, officers believe that its more consistent with that of distribution and not for personal use. Def.King was charged with possession with the intent to distribute.

Detective Samuels reviewed the multiple CCTV footage along with the clothing with defects that was recovered from Def.King and pictures of his shoes. At 8:45PM Def.King along with Suspects 2, 3, and 4 were walking south on the east sidewalk of the 3900 block of South Capitol Street Southeast. They cross over South Capitol Street and enter the parking lot on the west side. They eventually enter an establishment out of camera view for a few minutes then return to cross over towards the parking lot of 3916 South Capitol Street Southeast. Def.King stopped in the grassy area adjacent to the parking lot and makes a stance that appears that he was in possession of a firearm while the other Suspects entered the parking lot approaching the individuals that were already there. Suspect 2 and 3 approached a male while Suspect 3 displays a handgun. Suspect 4 approaches two males and starts to pat down their pockets. During this event, a white Chrysler 300 speeds out of the parking lot and Suspect 3 and 4 fire several shots towards the direction of the Chrysler 300's travel path. On another camera view, when the fleeing vehicle exits out the parking lot, a muzzle flash was observed from Def. King's hand while he was pointing towards the vehicle. Def.King turns around, hops and start to run north on the sidewalk. When he hops, a light is seen in the area of his hand and waist area. It appears that Def.King could of either shot himself or was struck in the crossfire from Suspect 3 and 4 shooting at the vehicle as he was in the path of the vehicle's travel. Def.King and all of the Suspects continue to run north on the sidewalk in front of the parking lot of 3850 South Capitol Street Southeast and out of the camera's view. From another camera, Suspect 5 was seen in the 7 Eleven parking lot shooting in the direction of the vehicle also.

Upon review of the footage, the clothing of Def.King was matched up by his shoes that were photographed and pants that were recovered with defects. There were also (5) cartridge casings located in the grassy area where Def.King was observed during the attempted robbery. Def.King was given the additional charge of Assault with the intent to Rob while armed.

Def King was identified using investigative databases as King, Delvon B/M DOB 1/21/1989 and was eventually transported to the Seventh District for processing.

The event and acts described above occurred primarily in the District of Columbia and were committed as described by defendant(s) listed in the case caption.
