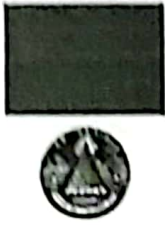

## DEFAULT JUDGMENT

International Document

Notice to Agent is Notice to Principal - Notice to Principal is Notice to Agent

### Stare Decisis

*See First Nat. Bank v. Terry, 103 Cal.App. 501, 285 P. 336, 377 ("Full faith and credit" clause of Const. U.S. art 4, § 1, requires that foreign judgment be given such faith and credit as it had by law or usage of state of its origin. ").*

On or about October 6, 2022, defendant, Omar Aquino, was duly served with process at his mailing address (either directly or by their agent) via United States Postmaster certified mail (article/tracking # 7020 1810 0002 3169 3971) with the Affidavit of Dispute [Exhibit: A] with attachments EXHIBITS: A1 and A2, the Affidavit of Fact: Adverse Claim of Title and Reversion of Ancestral Estate [Exhibit: A1] and the attached Memorandum of Trust from the complainant, Lamont Maurice El, as authorized representative, ex rel. LAMONT BUTLER-EL.

The Affidavit of Dispute [Exhibit: A] with attachments EXHIBITS: A1 and A2 were the complainant's disputed the defendant's claim of the alleged debt associated with the misrepresented instrument - bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange titled folio number 56826, and the Affidavit of Fact: Adverse Claim of Title and Reversion of Ancestral Estate [Exhibit: A1] and the Memorandum of Trust was the complainant's adverse claim of aboriginal title to his inherited ancestral estate in reversion known as 2345 Mill Road, ALEXANDRIA, Virginia, by his reversionary interest therein pursuant to his treaty secured right to inherit as heir apparent by jus sanguinis under Article 22 of the

Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire, and the defendant was given five (5) days from that date to answer. The defendant failed to answer which constitutes default and stands as the defendant's admission by silence to there being no valid debt associated with folio number 56826, and there being no rebuttal to the complainant's claim of inheritance to his ancestral estate in reversion.

On or about October 19, 2022, the defendant, Omar Aquino, was duly served with process at his mailing address (either directly or by their agent) via United States Postmaster certified mail (article/tracking # 7020 1810 0002 3169 5159) with the Affidavit of Fact: Notice of Default [Exhibit: B] from the complainant with an attached invoice of \$3,059,715 being owed to the complainant by the defendant, Omar Aquino (et al.). There was no cause to the contrary made thereto by the defendant, Omar Aquino, or by anyone else similarly situated.

On or about February 16, 2023, the defendants, Omar Aquino, Sonya L. Sacks, Marion W. Jackson, Jessica Glajch, and Edward J. Longosz II were duly served with process at their mailing address (either directly or by their agent) with the Affidavit of Fact: Writ of Quo Warranto [Exhibit: B-QUO] from the complainant, which was entered in the records of case number GV22-6109, and served as the complainant's jurisdictional challenge via special appearance, in propria persona, sui juris, as authorized representative, ex rel. LAMONT BUTLER-EL in response to the defendants' collusive action under color of law in the form of an unconstitutional bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange titled SUMMONS FOR UNLAWFUL DETAINER (CIVIL CLAIM FOR EVICTION) dated January 4, 2023, in the records of case number GV22-6109.

The defendants were given three (3) days from their receipt of the Writ of Quo Warranto to answer and prove jurisdiction and judicial authorization via delegation of authority from Congress

under Article III sections 1 and 2 of the Constitution for the United States of North America. The defendants failed to answer and prove jurisdiction which constitutes default.

On or about February 21, 2023, the defendants were duly served with process at their mailing address (either directly or by their agent) with the Affidavit of Fact: Default Judgment [Exhibit: C-DEF] from the complainant, which was entered in the records of case number GV22-6109, and ordered for the defendants to dismiss case number GV22-6109 with prejudice along with any other attachments associated thereto for lack of jurisdiction and fraud. There was no cause to the contrary made thereto by the defendants. However, the defendants failed to execute their duty which constitutes wanton negligence and breach of duty. See *Kolovrat v. Oregon*, 366 U. S. 187, 194, 81 S.Ct. 922 (1961) (*"A state cannot refuse to give foreign nationals their treaty rights because of fear that valid international agreements may possibly not work completely to the satisfaction of state authorities. Under the supremacy clause of the United States Constitution Art. VI, clause 2, state policies as to the rights of aliens to inherit must give way to overriding federal treaties and conflicting arrangements."*).

Wherefore, it is this 12<sup>th</sup> day in the month of October, 2023, in the Morocco Consular Court at the Virginia Commonwealth,

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that a default judgment be and the same is hereby entered against the defendants, Sonya L. Sacks, Marion W. Jackson, Jessica Glajch, Edward J. Longosz II, and Omar Aquino (hereinafter "Judgment Debtors");

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the complainant, Lamont Maurice El (hereinafter "Judgment Creditor"), shall recover from the Judgment Debtors the judgment as follows:

i. The immediate dismissal with prejudice of case number GV22-6109 and any other attachments associated thereto for lack of jurisdiction and fraud;

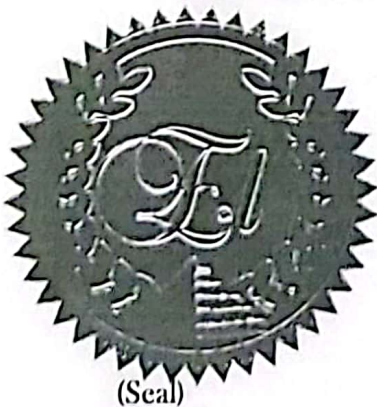
ii. The total principal amount of \$3,059,715 payable in lawful money of .9999 fine silver bullion coins and / or bars due forthwith;


It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that a judgment lien be and the same is hereby entered against the oaths of office, surety bonds, and all property (real and personal; corporeal and incorporeal) and assets of the Judgment Debtors and their spouse, their heir(s), successor(s), and assign(s) in order to secure the performance of this judgment, and to levy on such property and assets for the satisfaction of this judgment if payment cannot be made by the Judgment Debtors;

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that judgment for possession of the ancestral estate in reversion known as 2345 Mill Road, ALEXANDRIA, Virginia, (and more fully described in the attached Affidavit of Fact: Adverse Claim of Title and Reversion of Ancestral Estate [Exhibit: A1]) is hereby delivered to the Judgment Creditor, in allodium, as rightful heir and reversioner owner by Aboriginal title;
