January 4, 2023, and all attachments associated thereto; and the de facto administrative hearing scheduled for January 25, 2023.

For the record, I am Lamont Maurice El, a natural person, in full life in propria persona (not pro se), sui juris. My nationality is Moorish-American, being a master of the west (widow's son), aboriginal inhabitant of the land and heir apparent of the present Moroccan Empire by jus sanguinis. I hereby make special appearance as authorized representative, ex rel. LAMONT BUTLER-EL, and I object to your foreign jurisdiction and to the de facto administrative hearing scheduled for January 25, 2023, on the grounds of lack of jurisdiction, fraud, and improper venue due to the following errors:

1. The foreign de facto ALEXANDRIA CITY GENERAL DISTRICT COURT (Inc.) and the acting administrative clerks thereof including you, Marion W. Jackson, were not lawfully delegated judicial authorization and consular jurisdiction from Congress under Article III, sections 1 and 2 of the Constitution for the United States of North America to hear and decide disputes between Moorish-Americans and citizens of the United States as authorized under Articles 20 and 21 of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire, and, thus, lack jurisdiction. See *Elliot v. Peirson*, 26 U.S. 328, 340 (1828) ("Courts are constituted by authority and they cannot act beyond the powers delegated to them. If a court acts without authority, its judgments and orders are regarded as nullities. They are not



voidable, but simply void, and form no bar to a recovery sought in opposition to them, even prior to a reversal. They constitute no justification; and all persons concerned in executing such judgments, or sentences, are considered, in law, as trespassers.").

2. There is no evidence of a identifiable natural person that has established his or her standing as the alleged plaintiff/injured party in case no. GV22-6109, and there is no evidence of an alleged written accusation made against me and signed under oath or affirmation by the alleged plaintiff/injured party, and no such evidence exist! See *Allen v. Wright*, 468 U.S. 737, 751 (1984) ("The requirement of standing, however, has a core component derived directly from the Constitution. A plaintiff must allege personal injury fairly traceable to the defendant's allegedly unlawful conduct and likely to be redressed by the requested relief."); and see *Trinsey v. Pagliaro*, 229 F. Supp. 647 ("Statements of counsel in their briefs or arguments are not sufficient for purposes of granting a motion to dismiss or for summary judgment."). Therefore, case no. GV22-6109 constitutes a collusive action under color of law within purview of the unconstitution 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment for the purpose of fraud in the inducement, and is notwithstanding, unconstitutional, null and void ab initio, and unenforceable. See *United States v. Throckmorton*, 98 U.S. 61, 25 L. Ed. 93 ("Fraud vitiates the most solemn contracts, documents, and even judgments").

3. The above listed errors violate my right to due process of law which is secured under ~~the~~ Article III section 2, and the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution for the United States of



America.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED and ADJUDGED that a writ of error be and the same is hereby entered against you, Marion W. Jackson, Jessica Glajch, Edward J. Longest II, and Omar Aquino;

It is further ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the misrepresented instruments - bills of attainder / foreign bills of exchange styled as case no. GV22-6109 and titled SUMMONS FOR UNLAWFUL DETAINMENT (CIVIL CLAIM FOR EVICTION) dated January 4, 2023, and all attachments associated thereto, including the de facto administrative hearing scheduled for January 25, 2023, are unconstitutional notwithstanding, null and void ab initio, and are unenforceable for lack of jurisdiction and fraud, and shall be dismissed <sup>with prejudice</sup> forthwith.


