Memorandum

On or about December 12, 2022, you were served with process (either directly or by and through your agent/representative) with the Affidavit of Fact: Writ of Error [Exhibit: B] which was entered into the records of de facto case no. C-08-CR-22-000652, and which stands as conclusive evidence of the misrepresented instruments - bills of attainder / foreign bills of exchange titled WRIT OF SUMMONS - CRIMINAL dated December 5, 2022, and INDICTMENT filed on December 2, 2022, and any other attachments associated thereto being unconstitutional, notwithstanding, null and void ab initio, and unenforceable for lack of

jurisdiction and fraud. See Constitution for the United States of North America Article 1, section 9, clause 3 ("No Bill of Attainder shall be passed."); and Article 1, section 10, clause 1 ("No state shall pass any bill of attainder"); and see United States v. Throckmorton, 98 U.S. 61, 25 L. Ed. 93 ("Fraud vitiates the most solemn contracts, documents, and even judgments.").

On or about January 6, 2023, you were served with process (either directly or by and through your agent/representative) with the Affidavit of Fact: Writ of Error [Exhibit: C] which was entered into the records of de facto case no. C-08-CR-22-000652, and which stands as conclusive evidence of the misrepresented instrument - bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange titled CRIMINAL NOTICE OF HEARING / TRIAL dated December 29, 2022, and any other attachments associated thereto, including the de facto administrative hearing held on December 30, 2022, and scheduled for February 3, 2023, March 3, 2023, March 31, 2023, and April 19, 2023, being unconstitutional, notwithstanding, null and void ab initio, and unenforceable for lack of jurisdiction and fraud.

On or about January 6, 2023, you were served with process (either directly or by and through your agent/representative) with the Affidavit of Fact: Writ of Quo Warranto [Exhibit: D] which was entered into the records of de facto case no. C-08-CR-22-000652, and which commanded for evidence of lawful jurisdiction and judicial authorization (among other things) to be produced for the record, and you were given three (3) days from that date to execute this duty. As of this date you have failed to answer and prove your lawful jurisdiction and judicial authorization which constitutes default,

and serves as your admission by silence to there being no evidence of your jurisdiction or judicial authorization; no evidence of an identifiable natural person standing as plaintiff / injured party / victim alleging personal injury, nor is there a written accusation signed under oath or affirmation by the same (the STATE OF MARYLAND is a foreign de facto corporation, an abstraction, and a creature of the mind only, and therefore cannot contest or contend with a natural living man or woman); no evidence of a lawful 4th Amendment warrant for you to deprive me of my liberty, privacy, or my private and personal property / effects under your custody against my consent; no evidence of a valid and verifiable contract or commercial agreement mutually made between you and I, which would obligate me to any specific performance or subject me to the color of any law, statute, code, rule, regulation, or custom of the STATE OF MARYLAND (Inc.); no evidence of me identifying myself as LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER (Race: Black) or me consenting to stand as surety for the same at any point, or at any moment, or at any time; and no evidence of me being lawfully served with process or making an appearance in de facto case no. C-08-CR-22-000652. See Hagans v. Levine, 415 U.S. 533 ("The law requires proof of jurisdiction to appear on the record of the administrative agency and all administrative proceedings.").

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED and ADJUDGED that a default judgment be and the same is hereby entered against you, Monise A. Brown, H. James West, Lisa E. Yates, Michael Brown, Tiffany L. Campbell, Anthony B. Covington, Troy D. Berry, Brandon Foster, Brian Moore #512, Garner #545, C. Cooley #710, Morrison #615, McPherson #331, Hawkins #408, Halterman #732, Michael Almassy, and including Jonathan Beattie, Kenneth A. Talley, Karen Mitchell, and Mackisha Gross (hereinafter "Judgment Debtors");

It is further ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the Judgment Debtors are hereby obligated to I, Lamont Maurice E. (hereinafter "Judgment Creditor"),

for the following judgment due forthwith:

- i. the immediate dismissal with prejudice of de facto case no. C-08-CR-22-000652 and any attachments associated thereto, and closure of the same for lack of jurisdiction and fraud;
- ii. the immediate and unconditional release of the Judgment Creditor [falsely detained ex rel. LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER, D.O.B. 05/15/1984, Race: Black] from the custody of the Judgment Debtors due to unlawful imprisonment;
- iii. the immediate and unconditional release of the private and personal property/effects of the Judgment Creditor from the custody of the Judgment Debtors (et al.) to be returned to the Judgment Creditor due to unlawful seizure, to include, but not limited to, any and all firearms, magazines, ammo, bulletproof vest and carrier, badges, patches, uniform (shirt and pants), t-shirt, boots, scarf, sunglasses, crystal necklace, backpack with all contents therein, etc.; and
- iv. the total principle amount of \$255,000,000 in lawful money, 9999 fine silver bullion coins or bars due forthwith for compensatory damages, unless the Judgment Creditor settles for a lower amount;


It is further ORDERED and ADJUDGED that a judgment lien be and the same is hereby entered against the oath(s) of office, surety bond(s), property (real and personal; corporeal and incorporeal) and asset(s) belonging to or in the name of the Judgment Debtors and their spouse, their heir(s), successor(s) and assign(s), and belonging to or in the name of the STATE OF MARYLAND (Inc.) / State of Maryland (Inc.) and subsidiary(ies) to secure the performance and payment of this judgment, and to levy such property and asset(s) if payment cannot be made by the Judgment Debtors no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this judgment.

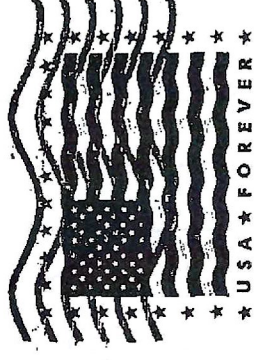
