Officer KRMENEC, T Badge 3308, personally appeared on 8/6/11 and under penalty for making a false statement, set forth the below statement regarding the named defendant as true and/or as based upon information s/he believes to be true, and that the events occurred in the District of Columbia.

The event occurred on 08/06/2011 at approximately 2000 at T BLOCK OF MICHIGAN AVE in Washington DC.

The event occurred on 8/6/11 at approximately 2000 at Unit block of Michigan Ave NW in Washington DC.

The undersigned and MPO Laboy (#3602) were assigned to the 3rd Watch (1400-2230), PSA 501, and Scout Car Traffic 501.

While on patrol travelling westbound in Unit block of Michigan Ave NW, officers observed a black Dodge Magnum (VIN: [REDACTED]) bearing DC tags of CS0381. A WALES/NCIC on the scout cars MDT revealed the DC tag had expired on 6/11/09. As a result, Officer Krmenech initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the Unit block of Michigan Ave NW. Then I asked D-1 for his driver's license, registration and insurance. D-1 stated he doesn't need to have a contract with this government and that D-1 is a Nationalist. D-1 stated his name was El, Lamont (DOB: 5/15/84) by word of mouth. D-1 stated he didn't have permit for his country. At no time did D-1 give officers his license or registration. A WALES/NCIC check revealed that D-1 didn't have a license for DC and the DC tags of CS0831 had expired on 6/11/09. D-1 was asked to step out of the vehicle.

At the station, D-1 was identified by his DC license as BUTLER, LAMONT MAURICE (DOB: 5/15/84 [REDACTED]) A WALES/NCIC check revealed that D-1's DC license had expired on 5/15/11.

As a result of the above facts and investigation, D-1 was placed under arrest for Unregistered Vehicle, Fail to Exhibit Permit, Failure to Exhibit Registration, and No DC Permit and transported to the 5th District for processing.
