## Stare Decisis Doctrine

See *Miranda v. Arizona*, 384 U.S. 436, 125 ("Where rights secured by  
the Constitution are involved, there can be no rule-making or legislation  
which would abrogate them.").

I, Lamont Maurice El, a natural person, in full life, in propria  
persona (not 'pro se'), sui juris, making special appearance as  
authorized representative, ex rel. LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER, do  
hereby object to being held on no bond, and I demand that the

bail review hearings scheduled for May 3, 2023, in no. C-08-CR-22-000652 and in related no. 08-K-13-000884 be forthwith advanced to either May 1, 2023, or May 2, 2023, only if you, Mr. Hayward James West, are available on those dates, and that these hearings (whether on the above dates or after) be held remotely and concurrent before you, Mr. Hayward James West, and not before Mrs. (or Ms.) Carrington or anyone else similarly situated, and I demand to be released on personal recognizance and assert the following grounds in support:

1. Since November 13, 2022, I have been <sup>inflicted with punishment and</sup> deprived of my rights to my liberty, my nationality and in full life status (allodial) under color of law and without due process of law as a result of the unconstitutional bill of attainder titled case number D-042-CR-22-002199 in the records of the foreign de facto DISTRICT COURT FOR CHARLES COUNTY (Inc.), which later became the unconstitutional bill of attainder titled case number C-08-CR-22-000652 on or about December 2, 2022, absent of a judicial trial.
2. On November 15, 2022, Mr. Kenneth A. Talley issued a de facto ruling under color of law by color of authority that I, under the fictitious corporate name / nom de guerre and civilly dead status, i.e., LAMONT MAURICE BUTLER (Race: Black), be held without bond; and on April 11, 2023, Mrs. (or Ms.) Donine Carrington issued the same hold without bond ruling de facto under color of law by color of authority. Mr. Talley and Mrs. (or Ms.) Carrington did not produce any lawful justification and as a result did abrogate my right to liberty by their de facto rule-making without due process of law in violation of my

rights secured under the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution for the United States of America, which aver the following (in part): "No person shall be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law."

3. As a result of the above, I am suffering from mental anguish because I have been physically separated from my children, my relatives and my loved ones, and I am presently suffering from <sup>I am denied fresh outside air and sunlight, and</sup> inhumane treatment because <sup>I was forced to be housed in a cell</sup> I was forced to be housed in a cell with three (3) people (although the cell was made for only two (2) people) due to over population, and I have not been convicted of any crime but I am being treated as if I have been.

4. While I am being held captive I am <sup>unable to have access</sup> ~~unable to have access~~ to my evidence elsewhere (located in a safe and secure place) which would prove my innocence and protection, and this is because I am being deprived of my liberty to obtain such evidence myself which constitutes me being deprived of my due process rights secured under the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution for the United States of America.

5. From the year 1929 to 1933 all gold and silver coins were taken out of public circulation per the Emergency Banking Act of March 9, 1933, therefore, I am unable to lawfully pay any dollar amount on a bail bond for my release in accordance with Article I, section 10, clause 1 of the Constitution for the United States of America because I do not have any gold or silver coins to lawfully pay with. Consequently, any dollar amount set on a bail bond for my release would be considered excessive and construed as a violation of my right to be free from excessive bail which is

secured under the 8<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution for the United States of America, which over the following (in part): "No excessive bail shall be required."


WHEREFORE, I demand for an advanced bail review hearing in no. C-08-CR-22-000652 and in related no. 08-K-13-000884 to be held remotely and concurrent before you, Mr. Hayward James West, and I demand to be released on personal recognizance.


