









Memorandum

On or about June 7, 2023, defendant Mahasin S. El Amin, et al., conspired to deprive a related Moorish-American national Wilkinson-Bey of her treaty right to inherit her ancestral estate in reversion under Article 22 of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United States of North America and the Moroccan Empire in the collusive action under color of law via the misrepresented instrument - bill of attainder / foreign bill of exchange titled case number C-16-CV-23-002644 in the records of the foreign de facto CIRCUIT COURT FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (Inc.) within purview of the unconstitutional 14th Amendment. The same type of collusive action is being taken under color of law against the complainant McKinney-El, a Moorish-American national, by the defendants Mahasin S. El Amin, Robin D. Gill Bright, Gladys M. Weatherspoon, Elizabeth Coleman Jones, Nikita Fain, John Alexander Nader. and Peter D. Sullivan in case number CAEF22-26634. Such actions violate stare decisis law in the case Kolovrat v. Oregon, 366 U. S. 187, 194, 81 S.Ct. 922 (1961) which the Supreme Court of the United States decided, "A state cannot refuse to give foreign nationals their treaty rights because of fear that valid international agreements may possibly not work completely to the satisfaction of state authorities." Also, "Under the supremacy clause of the United States Constitution Art. VI, clause 2,

state policies as to the rights of aliens to inherit must give way to overriding federal treaties and conflicting arrangements."

On or about January 10, 2024, Wilkinson-Bey recorded the Affidavit of Fact: Writ of Quo Warranto [Exhibit: A] in related case number C-16-CV-23-002644 which challenged jurisdiction via special appearance, and the defendant, Mahasin S. El Amin, et al., were given three (3) days from that date to answer and prove jurisdiction according to due process of law under Article III and the 5th Amendment of the Constitution for the United States of North America. Since then, defendant Mahasin S. El Amin, et al., failed to answer quo warranto and prove jurisdiction which constitutes default.

On or about January 23, 2024, Wilkinson-Bey recorded the Affidavit of Fact: Default Judgment [Exhibit: C] in related case number C-16-CV-23-002644 which stands in the record as conclusive evidence of lack of jurisdiction and fraud.

The foreign de facto CIRCUIT COURT FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (Inc.) is not an Article III court of competent jurisdiction and was never delegated authority from Congress to hear and decide 'cases and controversies' under Article III section 1 and 2 of the Constitution for the United States of North America, nor was it authorized to hear 'diversity of nationality' cases under consular jurisdiction between Moorish-Americans and citizens of the United States under Articles 20 and 21 of the Treaty of Peace and Friendship of 1836 between the United Stated of North America and the Moroccan Empire. Therefore, any judgment or order issued by the foreign de facto CIRCUIT COURT FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (Inc.) is unconstitutional, notwithstanding, void ab initio and unenforceable for lack of jurisdiction and fraud. See Elliot v. Peirsol, 26 U.S. 328, 340 (1828) ("Courts are constituted by authority and they cannot act beyond the power delegated to them. If a court acts without authority, its judgments and orders are regarded

as nullities. They are not voidable, but simply void; and form no bar to a remedy sought in opposition to them, even prior to a reversal. They constitute no justification; and all persons concerned in executing such judgments, or sentences, are considered, in law, as trespassers.").

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that a writ of error be and the same is hereby entered against the defendants, Robin D. Gill Bright, Gladys M. Weatherspoon, Mahasin S. El Amin, Elizabeth Coleman Jones, Nikita Fain, John Alexander Nader, and Peter D. Sullivan;

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the misrepresented instruments – bills of attainder / foreign bills of exchange titled ORDER OF RATIFICATION OF SALE AND REFERRAL TO AUDITOR dated July 8, 2024, and NOTICE / AVISO dated July 10, 2024, and ORDER filed on May 10, 2023, and ORDER filed on February 6, 2023, and ORDER filed on December 27, 2022, and any other attachments associated thereto are UNCONSTITUTIONAL, NOTWITHSTANDING, NULL and VOID AB INITIO and are UNENFORCEABLE for lack of jurisdiction and fraud;

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the collusive action and de facto administrative proceedings under color of law in case number CAEF22-26634 in the records of foreign de facto CIRCUIT COURT FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (Inc.) and any other attachments associated thereto are UNCONSTITUTIONAL, NOTWITHSTANDING, NULL

and VOID AB INITIO and are UNENFORCEABLE and CLOSED for lack of jurisdiction and fraud;
