Beaufort Shag Club Board of Directors Meeting January 2, 2023

The Beaufort Shag Club Board of Directors met on January 2, 2023, at AmVets at 6:30 PM. Directors present were: Rob Blumer, Marsha Grayson, Gail Greenway, Myra Griemel, Ray Kneisel, Brenda Lesesne, and Donna Reynolds. Six additional club members were also in attendance.

Call to Order: President Ray Kneisel called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Approval of December 5, 2022, Minutes: Rob Blumer made the motion to accept the previous minutes with the correction of the date the Progressive Jackpot begins. Marsha Grayson seconded the motion, and the motion passed.




