WASHINGTON, DC – Meet [Mitchell Montalbano](#), a 9-year-old from Hendersonville, Tennessee, who like many of his friends, likes superheroes, sports, and being outdoors. In August 2014, Mitchell was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia, the most common type of childhood cancer.



Mitchell's mom, Kristy, remembers the day vividly, saying it all began with a fever. An initial exam from Mitchell's doctor led to him being rushed to Monroe Carrell Jr. Children's Hospital for additional testing. Mitchell's doctors told the family to prepare for more than three years of treatment. "That's 3 ½ years of chemotherapy, steroids, spinal taps, and a list of other medications for side effects he would have to be on," Kristy explained. Mitchell began receiving treatment, which led to side effects – nausea, exhaustion, and loss of hair. But what came next was far tougher for Mitchell.

Given his weakened immune system, it was too dangerous for Mitchell to leave the house. Kristy recalls having to explain to Mitchell why he couldn't go to pre-school, soccer practice, swimming with friends, or out to dinner as a family. Miraculously, Mitchell began a new treatment the next month and has been in remission since September 28, 2014.

Last week, #MightyMitchell flew up to Washington to participate in a [briefing](#) on The Healing Power of the Human-Animal Bond. The event highlighted the unique bond between humans and animals, particularly during times of healing. Needless to say, [Mitchell stole the show](#).

What's next for Mitchell? The sky's the limit. He'll start kindergarten in the fall, and wants to be a scientist when he grows up. The future is bright, for Mighty Mitchell.
