



2020 TOWN CLASS “WORLDS” & NATIONAL REGATTA
Notice of Regatta



Hosted by the Marblehead Town Class Association and
Corinthian Yacht Club
July 31 - August 2, 2020

1. **Rules:** Racing will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
2. **Eligibility and Entry:** The Regatta is open to all Town Class boats that have registered with the Marblehead Town Class Association (MTCA) for this Regatta.
 - 2.1 **Entry:** Entry can be made by submitting the entry form to tuulasnow@hotmail.com. The entry form will be posted on www.townclass.net.
 - 2.2 **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is \$20.
 - 2.3 **Sailing Instructions:** SI's will be available online at www.townclass.net.
 - 2.4 **All boats are required to abide by the state and local laws, guidelines, and recommendations as well as the host clubs' restrictions with regard to the COVID-19 virus.**

3. **Regatta Racing Schedule**

There will be no Skippers Meetings due to COVID-19 guidelines.

Friday, July 31 Worlds - 1330 First warning harbor start

Saturday, August 1 Nationals - 1100 First warning for first race - Archer's Rock Line or Brimbles Rock Line

Sunday, August 2 Nationals - 1030 First warning for first race - Archer's Rock Line or Brimbles Rock Line

Additional races will be held on all three days, if possible and if multiple races are held the same time sequence will be used.

The finish line for the last race on Saturday afternoon may be in the harbor, CYC line, between the CYC race committee booth and mark "O" on the CYC Cooke Sunday Racing Chart. This will be indicated by the Race Committee signal boat by flying Code Flag 'F' before the warning signal. The course will be indicated using MRA courses with the finish as indicated above. If the race committee determines that marks will be rounded to starboard, a green flag will be flown before the warning signal. For example, if course B is sailed, competitors shall start, round the windward mark, leeward mark and then proceed to the harbor finish line which may or may not be upwind of the leeward mark based on sea and wind conditions. If a green flag is flown, marks shall be rounded to starboard.

4. **Time Limit:** No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Friday and Saturday and after 1430 hours on Sunday.
5. **Sailing Instructions**
 - 5.1 **The Worlds:** will use the 2020 CYC Cooke Sunday Series sailing instructions except as modified by sailing instructions for this event to be issued later.
 - 5.2 **The Nationals:** will use the 2020 MRA sailing instructions except as modified by sailing instructions for this event to be issued later.
