**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. The Town Class "Nationals" will use the 2020 Marblehead Racing Association Sailing Instructions except as modified herein.
2. In **#2 Notices to Competitors** delete "racing home page. [https://theclubspot.com/regatta /NQT4vm6VYE](https://theclubspot.com/regatta/NQT4vm6VYE)" and substitute the following: "**www.townclass.net** and at **www.corinthianyc.org.**"
3. In **#4 Signals Made Ashore** delete "BYC" and "EYC and will be repeated by text to the competitors." in the first sentence.
4. In **#5 Schedule of Races** delete the first sentence and #5.1 and substitute the following for #5.3:  
**5.3** The first warning on Saturday will be at 1100 and on Sunday at 1030.
5. Delete **#7 Racing Areas** and substitute the following:  
The racing area, a circle approximately 1 mile in diameter, will be with a start/finish line in the Archer's Rock area, (Mark 20 on the course chart) or in the Brimbles Rock area (behind Cat Island) at the discretion of the Race Committee. The finish line for the last race on Saturday afternoon may be in the harbor, CYC line, between the CYC race committee booth and mark "O" on the 2020 Town Class Worlds Racing Chart. This will be indicated by the Race Committee signal boat by flying Code Flag 'F' before the warning signal. The course will be indicated using MRA courses with the finish as indicated above. If the race committee determines that marks will be rounded to starboard, a green flag will be flown before the warning signal. For example, if course B is sailed, competitors shall start, round the windward mark, leeward mark and then proceed to the harbor finish line which may or may not be upwind of the leeward mark based on sea and wind conditions. If a green flag is flown, marks shall be rounded to starboard.
6. In **#8 The Courses** delete #8.6.
7. In **#9 Marks** delete #9.1 and in #9.2 delete the first sentence, change the second sentence to read as follows: "When Mark 1 is red, a change mark will be identified by a black band, and a subsequent change will be unbanded." and delete the third sentence. Delete #9.5.
8. In **#11 The Finish** add the following:  
**11.4** The finish line for the last race on Saturday afternoon may be in the harbor, CYC line, between the CYC race committee booth and mark "O" on the 2020 Town Class Worlds Racing Chart. This will be indicated by the Race Committee signal boat by flying Code Flag 'F' before the warning signal. The course will be indicated using MRA courses with the finish as indicated above. If the race committee determines that marks will be rounded to starboard, a green flag will be flown before the warning signal. For example, if course B is sailed, competitors shall start, round the windward mark, leeward mark and then proceed to the harbor finish line which may or may not be upwind of the leeward mark based on sea and wind conditions. If a green flag is flown, marks shall be rounded to starboard.
9. In **#13 Time Limits and Target Times** add the following:  
**13.3** No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Saturday and after 1430 hours on Sunday.
10. In **#15 Scoring** add the following:  
**15.3** One race shall constitute a series. If 5 or more races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from their series score.

11. In **#19 Radio Communication** delete the following; “Channel 78 for the South Line and VHF Channel 71 for the North Line” and substitute the following: The **VHF channel** in use during this regatta will be **69**.
12. Delete **#20 Prizes** and substitute the following:  
The top three finishers will receive trophies. The top finisher will receive the Town Class National Trophy. Trophies will also be awarded to the winner of each race. Awards presentations will be following the regular MTCA racing season at the awards dinner.
13. Add the following: **Sailing Instructions** and all other regatta documents will be available online at [www.townclass.net](http://www.townclass.net) and at [www.corinthianyc.org](http://www.corinthianyc.org).
