2024 TOWN CLASS WORLDS Organizing Authority is the Marblehead Town Class Association and The Corinthian Yacht Club AUGUST 2, 2024 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1. <u>RULES</u>:

- **1.1** Racing will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- **1.2** The Town Class specifications, Issue #7, with revisions of July 26, 2023, available at https://townclass.net/2024-nationals applies.

2. CHANGES TO THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

2.1 Changes to these instructions will be posted on the Town Class website <u>https://townclass.net/2024-nationals.</u> before noon on the day they will take effect and shall be signaled by displaying an "L" flag from the CYC yardarm.

3. COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS:

- **3.1** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at <u>https://townclass.net/2024-nationals</u>
- **3.2** The VHF communications channel will be channel 72.
- **3.3** Emergency conditions, race course information and/or requests for assistance **shall** be reported to the Corinthian race booth, which will be monitoring VHF 72
- **3.4** All participants are required to monitor the VHF for racing safety.
- **3.5** All boats <u>must</u> notify the race committee when they are withdrawing or retiring from a race at the first reasonable opportunity by VHF or call 617-529-2262.

4. <u>CODE OF CONDUCT</u>:

4.1 [DP} Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE:

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the CYC yardarm.

6. RACE AREA:

6.1 The racing area is as shown Addendum "B".

7. <u>COURSES:</u>

- 7.1 Applicable race marks will be posted at the Race Committee booth, as read from your <u>left</u> to your <u>right</u>. An attempt will be made to announce the race course over VHF.
- **7.2** Except as noted in #13.1, a mark shall be passed on the side farthest from the next mark. In the case of a <u>single mark course, it shall be rounded to port</u>.
- 7.3 Twice around courses will be indicated with the posting of code flag "T" and three times around courses will be indicated with the posting of U.S. Navy "#3" signal flag along with the posted course marks. Mark "O" will not be posted but must be <u>rounded</u>, unless the course has been shortened at Mark "O" by the posting of code flag "<u>S</u>" and two blasts of an air horn.

8. <u>MARKS:</u>

8.1 Marks are listed in Addendum "A".

9. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

- **9.1** The warning signal for the first race will be at 1:30 PM with a harbor start.
- **9.2** Additional races will be held, if possible, using the same time sequence. To alert boats that a race or starting sequence will begin soon, an announcement will be made on the VHF.
- **9.3** No warning signal will be made after 1600 hours.

10. AUDIBLE SIGNALS:

10.1 All starting, general recall, and first-place finishing signals will be by siren. OCS, changed and shortened course signals will be by air horn.

11. OBSTRUCTIONS:

11.1 Racers shall <u>NOT</u> proceed between Childrens Island and Comorant Rock --- or between Eagle Island and Nun #6 to the northwest of Eagle Island.

12. START/FINISH LINE:

12.1 The following table will be used to start the first race, and any subsequent races will use the same system. This changes RRS 26.

1:30 PM	Warning (Yellow shape + audible)
1:32 PM	Yellow removed – no sound
1:33 PM	Preparatory (BLUE shape + audible)
1:35 PM	Blue removed – no sound
1:36 PM	Start (Red shape + audible)

- **12.2** The start and finish line will be formed by a line between an orange cylinder (Racing Mark "O") and an orange plank on the CYC Race Committee Booth Railing. Mark "O" will not be displayed in the course description.
- **12.3** When a boat is OCS (On Course Side: aka, over early) code flag "X" will be posted with one sound of the air horn and an attempt will be made to notify all OCS boats on the VHF. The failure to hail, the order of hail, the hail of some but not all, the failure of a boat to hear such a hail, or the untimely hail of OCS boats will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a)
- 12.4 General recall will be signaled by two sounds from the siren after the start, posting of the "First Substitute" signal pennant and an announcement will be made on the VHF. The next siren (3 minutes from the recalled start) will be the Preparatory signal with the start 3 minutes later. (Changes RRS 29.2)
- **12.5** Additional races will be held, if possible.

13. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE:

13.1 Code flag "<u>C</u>" shall be posted when a change of course is required for a second or third circuit of the race. Repetitive blasts of an air horn will call your attention to the *new* mark(s) to be rounded. The *new* mark(s) shall be posted before this signal is given. Mark "<u>O</u>" shall be rounded as if the course had not been changed. The new mark(s) shall be rounded in the same manner as the previous course mark(s) (Passed on the side farthest from the next mark) and if the second or third circuit is a single mark, it shall be passed on the same side as mark "O" was passed. This changes RRS 33.

14. PENALTY SYSTEM

14.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

15. HEARING REQUESTS:

- **15.1** A boat that intends to protest, must fly a protest flag at the first reasonable opportunity. This changes RRS 61.1(a)(2).
- **15.2** The protest time limit is 1 hour after the last boat finishes. This time will be posted on the Town Class web site <u>https://townclass.net/2024-nationals</u>.
- 15.3 Protest forms are available at <u>https://townclass.net/2024-nationals</u>. Such forms shall be submitted at the Protest desk located at Corinthian race booth, and e-mailed to <u>industrialtech@comcast.net</u>. Protestors shall provide e-mail addresses and mobile numbers for the protestor, protestee and any witnesses.
- **15.4** Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- **15.5** Hearings will be held at the Corinthian Yacht Club Race Committee Booth.
- **15.6** Protest hearings will be held after racing.

16. TIME LIMITS:.

- **16.1** The time limit for the first boat to finish will be 1 1/2 hours.
- 16.2 The Finishing Window is the time for boats to finish after the first boat sails the course and finished. Boats failing to finish with in the Finishing Window, and not subsequently retiring, being penalized or given redress, will be scored Time Limit Expired, (TLE) without a hearing. The boat will be scored points place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished with in the Finishing Window. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2, and A10.
- **16.3** The Finishing Window will be 30 minutes.

17. SCORING:

- **17.1** One race will constitute the series.
- **17.2** A boat that is scored OCS, DNC, DNS, DNF, NSC, RET, or DSQ shall be scored points for finishing place one more than the number of boats that started that race. This changes RRS A5.2.
