John Bellany Day Centre are very keen to expand its range of services to provide Outreach Support to our older population in Cockenzie, Port Seton, and Longniddry.

We see our role as providing social support, not medical intervention, as this type of service is offered by health and private agencies who already operate within these communities. We are conscious that not all our older population have family, carer or neighbour support and may need others to assist them with e.g. shopping, making personal appointments and getting to them, domestic tasks or other items that they can no longer manage.

Family and carers may be providing daily support to a loved one and need some respite. A sitter service may be a useful option to alleviate some of the stress of constant care.

All of these and more may be items that you face daily. We need to hear from you to tell us what would be helpful to you. Please do this whether you are supported by family/carer or live alone.

The organisation is required to charge a fee for its service but the level of fee can be negotiated as part of the service agreement.

ABOUT OUR DAY CARE CENTRE

The John Bellany Day Centre is a registered charity with OSCR (Charity No SC024761) and inspected by the Care Inspectorate.

Our Centre provides care and support to the older adults in the **Longniddry, Port Seton and Cockenzie** areas and is open **Monday to Friday (Mon to Thurs - 9am to 4.30pm/Fri 9am to 4pm)**. We have our own minibus to collect and return our service users.

A light breakfast, a two-course lunch and afternoon snacks are provided. All dietary requirements are also catered for.

Music/Quizzes/Crafts/Entertainers/Outings and Special Events e.g. Burns Day, Valentines, Pancake day etc, are all part of our activities programme.

All staff are fully qualified and equipped to manage a full range of care and support needs.

Volunteers are often present to support staff.

There is a small financial charge required for attending the Centre.

The organisation governance is undertaken by a Board of Trustees and the service managed by a Registered Manager.
