This area included a saw mill, turpentine distilleries, cotton gin, grist mill, cooper shop, and general store, and was also a ateway to the coast. The Socastee Historic District, including the S. S. Sarvis House (1881), T. B. Cooper Store (1905), T. B. Cooper House (1908), and the Intracoastal Waterway Bridge (1936), was listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 2002.
