Common Signs and Symptoms of Certain Cancers

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS	TYPE OF CANCER
Change in bowel or bladder function	Colon, bladder, or prostate
Sores that do not heal	Skin or oral
White patches inside mouth or on tongue	Pre-cancerous area if not treated can become mouth cancer
Unusual bleeding or discharge	Lung, colon, rectal, cervix, endometrium, bladder, kidney, or breast
Thickening or lump	Breast, testicle, lymph nodes, and soft tissue
Indigestion or trouble swallowing	Esophagus, stomach, or throat
Change in wart/mole or new skin change	Melanoma
Nagging cough or hoarseness	Lung, larynx, or thyroid gland

There may be other causes for each of these symptoms, but it's important to see your physician if they occur.
