Harriet Hageman Just Sold Out Wyoming Families

Cheyenne, WY— In response to Republican Representative Harriet Hageman voting for the GOP's cruel, immoral budget that will gut health care, close rural hospitals, and devastate Wyoming communities, Wyoming Democratic Party has released the following statement:

It's hard to believe that Wyoming's lone Representative would vote for a bill so completely destructive to the state and people she represents, but moments ago, Harriet Hageman did just that. The GOP's budget bill will strip healthcare from thousands of her constituents, close rural hospitals across the state, and make it harder for working families to put food on the table.
