Wyoming Democrats Encourage Barrasso to Take His Deep Concern and Shove It

Cheyenne - After a disastrous Senate hearing with Secretary of Health and Human Services Robert F. Kennedy Jr. — in which Senator John Barrasso cited measles outbreaks, the firing of CDC Director Susan Monarez, mass resignations from vaccine advisory panels, and the NIH's rejection of mRNA science as causes for deep concern — the Wyoming Democratic Party has released the following statement:
