Removing barriers for local entrepreneurs and creating opportunities for them in their own communities.

Wilmington Alliance invests in <u>places:</u>

Places that have been devalued and disinvested need infrastructure investment that supports those who live there.



Wilmington Alliance invests in people:

- 2 greenspaces and 1 indoor community space created as community assets
- 6 years of free seasonal arts-based programming in the Rock Lot and 7th & West Park for the community
- 65 local artists employed to create projects or present programming since 2016
- 46 local artists empowered with new skills through free workshop programs
- Average of 30+ free public events seasonally in Alliance-created spaces that welcome all
- Neighborhood access to growing food in their community
- Continued advocacy around issues important to the community

Wilmington Alliance invests in places:

- Facilitated the move of NextFab to Wilmington to support artists and makers with a local "maker space" (2017)
- Created and completed 7 large-scale mural projects in WCC and other neighborhoods in collaboration with partners (2016- 2018)
- Created various art installations including sculpture garden on a vacant lot to raise awareness of alternative uses for vacancy (2015 – 2019)
- Installed lighting on 8 commercial properties to increase safety and support local businesses (2017-2019)
- 6 banner murals created, and lighting installed on Catawba St. (2018)
- Completed and opened The Rock Lot, the first greenspace of our Vacant to Vibrant initiative, located at 305 W 8th St. (2017)
- Remediated and built 7th & West St. Park and community garden (2019)
- With partners, stabilized 4 vacant lots in WCC with greening (2018)
- Installed 3 sculptural bicycle "Art Racks" (2022)
- Acquired and renovated the former blighted nuisance properties at 501 and 503 W 7th St to create the Art O Mat Community space and adjacent green space (expected completion April 2023)

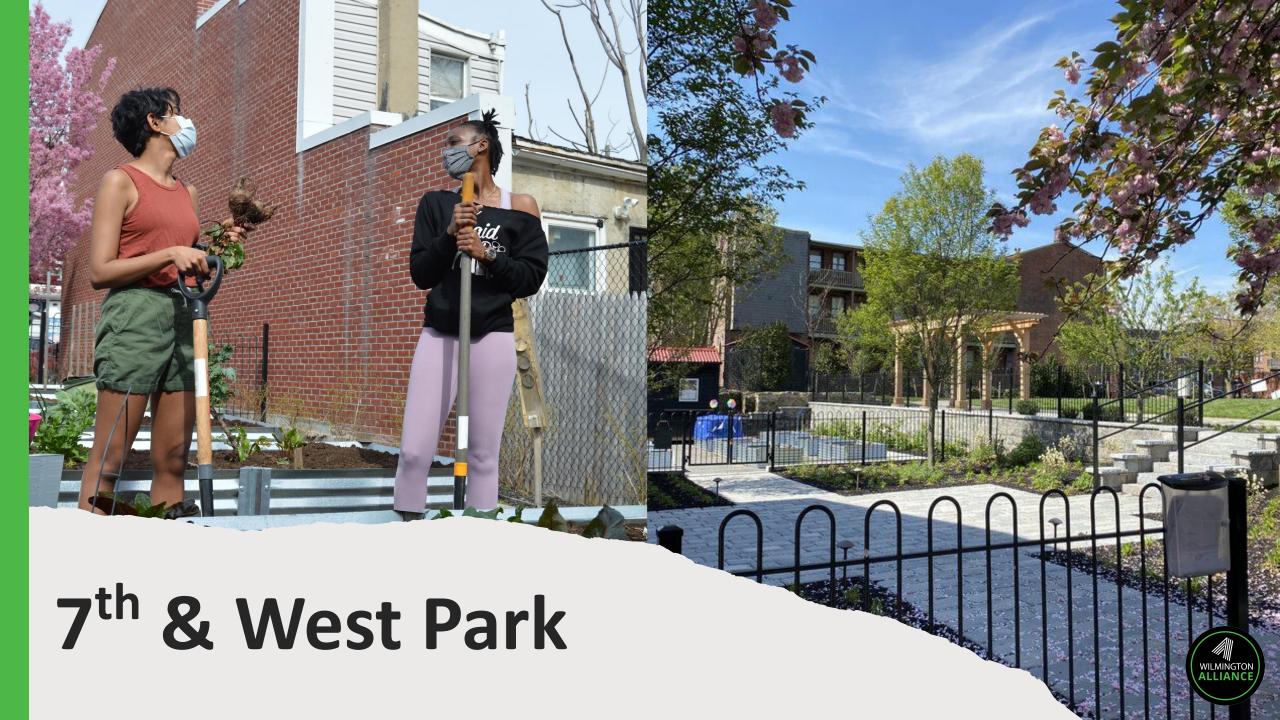
