

DEPARTMENT 16 – CHRISTMAS TREES

Trees for competitive exhibit must have been grown in the County on land owned or operated by the exhibitor.

Trees to be exhibited shall be within the 5 to 7 feet height range measuring from the bottom of the handle to the top of the tip.

No trees may be exhibited that have been sprayed with or have artificial color or other chemicals added in any manner.

No trees may be exhibited with limbs or foliage added that did not grow naturally in place.

Trees may be naturally grown or sheared and shaped by the exhibitor.

Entries must have a tag attached showing name and address of the exhibitor and class number in which the trees are to be exhibited. Only one (1) tree may be entered in each class by an exhibitor.

No holders should accompany trees. All trees will be supported in like manner.

Trees exhibited remain the property of the exhibitor and may be claimed after 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, after that time they become property of the fair.

Each exhibit is limited to one (1) entry in each class and/or sub-class.

The use of displaying of artificial flowers is prohibited and no premiums will be paid.

Plants positively will not be accepted for exhibition unless they have been growing in containers for two months.

The management will not undertake to return exhibits nor be responsible.

Baskets or containers must be supplied by the exhibitor and will be given every possible care, but the management assumes no responsibility for their safety.

Flowers or plants entered for competition must be more than ordinary standard and quality to be entitled to an awards.

The management may at any time order the removal of any exhibit which is in bad condition.

Any article manifestly unfit to show may be excluded.

All entities must be grown by exhibitor except in arrangement classes.

The judge's decision is final.

All exhibits must be at the Fairgrounds on Monday by noon.

Collections cannot compete for single premiums.

Exhibitors are requested to label variety names on all plants and flowers.

No articles accepted over 15" and/or over 20 pounds in weight.

Flowers in each entry must be of one color and variety unless otherwise stated.

One plant per pot.
