1. No swine showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show.
2. Individual animal ID is required. Id options include the following: (a.) A form of official ID (herd tattoo in combination with ear notch; or a state issued metal ear tag; or a Radio Frequency identification tag; or (b.) A plastic stamped ear tag.
3. All market swine must go directly to a state approved processing plant.

DEPARTMENT 6 – GOATS

NOTE: Fair may choose to list classes suggested by the American Goat Breeders Association in lieu of those listed here.

1. Get of Sire shall consist of three doe from a particular sire with not more than one under one year allowed and not more than one animal from every multiple bush allowed. Get of Sire need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Sire.
2. Produce of Dam shall consist of two doe of different ages. The produce of Dam need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Dam.
3. A Dairy Herd shall consist of three milking doe of one breed, any age.
4. The Senior Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in the first classes, or Doe 1 year old and under 2, in milk and older animals.
5. The Junior Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in classes 2 and 3, or Doe one year old and under 2 years, not in milk and younger animals.
6. Grand Champion Class shall consist of best of breed in each division.
7. Only Doe entered in other classes may compete in Get of Sire, Produce of Dam and Milking Herd classes.
