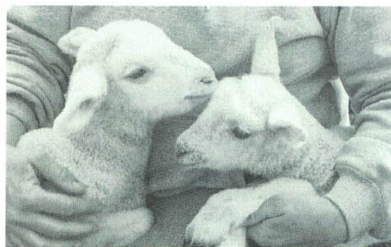

## Section 6 – Rabbits (Refer to General Rules)

Superintendent: Ashley Larson 814-203-0896 – See Health Requirements

1. Rabbits will be screened on arrival for health and show condition. No rabbits showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show. Exhibits accepted on Sunday from Noon–2:00 p.m. only.
2. Department Superintendent has the final judgment in resolving any dispute.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark.
4. Meat pens may be entered. They must consist of three (3) live rabbits, 70 days old or under; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
5. Single Fryer – not over 70 days old; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
6. Single Roaster – under 6 months of age; weigh between 5.5 and 9 lbs.
7. Single Stewer – 6 months of age or over; minimum weight 8 lbs.
8. The Fair Board and Superintendent are not responsible for the care and well-being of exhibitor's animal. However, all care will be taken to provide an adequate and safe environment for all animals.

1. Showmanship Contest is open to any youth not entered in 4-H who has a rabbit entered in the breed contest. Exhibitors will compete according to their age as of January 1st (4-H age) with the exception of the Novice Class (1st project year participating in Showmanship).
2. Rabbit used must be entered and shown in the Fair Rabbit Show and be owned by the exhibitor competing in this department.
3. Exhibitor must meet with the judge and be scored individually. The score will be based on the following: carrying the rabbit to the table, posing, checking ears, teeth, eyes and nose; checking toenails, hocks, front feet, abdomen, legs, and tail; checking sex, checking fur, the exhibitor's appearance, actions, and knowledge. Exhibitor's knowledge will be tested by answering questions related to the breed exhibited, diseases, and standard management practices. The exhibitor is not restricted to a specific order for the presentation.
4. Exhibitor will show in proper attire, which includes a long-sleeved top.


