1. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assignment without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.
2. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing.
3. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by the animals at shows shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judge.
4. Exhibitors must have all animals for competition on the grounds by Sunday at 9:00 p.m.

1. Joint ownership considered to be as one owner in accordance with registration papers.
2. Number of animals in any class to be entered by any one exhibitor shall be determined by Fair management.
3. When on exhibit in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner's representative.
4. All beef animals must be on grounds by 9:00 p.m. Sunday.
5.
