Dues must be paid in full by May 15th to avoid an additional late fee.

Sign-ups for swim lessons and swim team will be available in the office any time during normal hours as soon as the pool is open.



Note: If guests have not arrived for Adult Night by 9:30pm, guards will be sent home and the pool will be closed to keep unnecessary costs down.

Notifications for early closings for swim meets or inclement weather will be communicated via social media, and text alert.

Please have a plan of action and a designated place for unaccompanied children to go if the weather changes unexpectedly.

Once school starts in August, pool hours change to 5-8 pm on school nights. Additional details will be posted on social media. *The pool will close for the season on Labor Day, Sep 2nd 2024.*



Swim Team

Cost for the swim team will be \$70.00 for the first and second swimmer in a family, and \$60.00 for the third swimmer, with a maximum of \$200.00 per family. You must be a member of the pool to be on PL swim team. A \$50 deposit will be required for each swim team family, the deposit will be returned once families have volunteered at two swim meets.

Swim team practices are scheduled to begin May 27th with the first meet to be held in early June. Swimming finals will be in mid-July. Swim meets hosted at Prairie Lane need many volunteers, swim team parents are required to volunteer at a minimum of two home meets. **NOTE**

Child must have passed Level 5 of swim lessons or equivalent, and be able to swim one continuous length of the pool to be a member of swim team.

Swim Lessons

Cost for a two-week session will be \$55.00 for a Member, and \$70.00 for a non-member. Three sessions will be offered during the following weeks: June 3 – June 14 June 24 – July 8 (No lessons July 4th) July 15 – July 26 Each session consists of 10, thirty-minute lessons. Starting times offered at 11:00, & 11:30 am.

Pool Rules

These rules are for the protection and benefit of all members of the Prairie Lane Association, Inc. Their purpose is to assure safe, sanitary, and fun-filled operation of our

PARENTS please explain these rules to your children and insist that your children observe them. The Pool Manager and Pool Board have the authority to suspend any member of the Association for a period of up to 10 days for violating these rules.

<u>Continued or flagrant violations will lead to</u> <u>cancellation of membership</u>.



Pool Rules

<u>SWIMMING</u>

The pool will be open from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM Sunday through Saturday, except when closed for special events. The pool will remain closed, or will close, when the reported temperature is below 70. If temperatures reach 70 by 3:00 PM or 5:00 PM, the pool will open. Please watch for announcements, or feel free to call, to confirm that the pool is open.

Weekday mornings are reserved for swim team practices and group swim lessons. An adult or an older child (10 or older) must accompany children 8 years of age and younger to the pool. The wading pool is for children 5 years and under, every child must have adult supervision with them in the baby pool area. Diaper-age children must wear tight-fitting, waterproof pants. Children who have not passed the basic swimming test will be restricted to the intermediate wading area of the main pool, unless accompanied by a parent. Running, pushing, wrestling, snapping towels or causing other undue disturbances will not be permitted in the pool or on the deck. All diving shall be done off the end of the diving board. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. Diving from the edge of the pool is not permitted in the diving area. Swimming is not allowed in the diving area, except to leave the diving area. Floatation devices are never permitted when using the diving board. When instructed to clear the diving area, it must be done immediately. Upon request of a lifeguard, all swimmers must immediately get out of the water. Inflatable and floatation devices are prohibited including lifejackets, floaties etc, except in the wading pool. NO EXCEPTIONS.

RESPONSIBILITY

The Association is not responsible for accidents or injury to members or guests. The Association is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property. Facilities for checking clothing or valuables are not available. The only cash required will be that to pay guest fees and concessions. Adult members are responsible for their children and guests. Damage to any Association property will be charged to the member family, or if by a guest, to the adult registering the guest. Loss of membership may be a result of infractions to the pool rules.

SANITATION

No food or drinks allowed with-in 2 feet of the pool edge. This includes the wading pool. No pets allowed inside the bathhouse or on the pool deck. $\frac{1}{322}$ No person shall be permitted to use the pool without first taking a warm shower using soap.

No person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, cut, sore or lesion: eye, ear, nose or throat infection shall be admitted to the pool area. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, and any other similar activities are prohibited in the pool.

No running, boisterous or rough play shall be permitted in the pool, on the walkways, diving board, or in the pool area.

Absolutely **NO GLASS** containers allowed on pool deck or in pool area, including inside a cooler. NO EXCEPTIONS

Guests

Guest privileges are not extended to anyone residing in the area bounded by: Interstate 680 on the east: 120th Street on the west: West Center Street on the north: and the Union Pacific tracks on the south. Each member family is allowed admission privileges for guests residing outside of this area. An adult member must register all guests.

Guest fees are \$5.00 per day. House Guest: \$10.00 per week. House guests Family: \$20.00 per week. Houseguests are those people visiting you who reside outside the Omaha metropolitan area. All fees are payable at the time of registration.


Guest Passes will be held at the front desk, on a digital guest sheet with the guards. This will allow members the freedom from keeping track of guest passes as well as saving paper.

Guest cannot live within the neighborhood boundaries. Please respect this rule, violators will be asked to leave.

General

Members paying the full price Family Membership may add a babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker to their membership for their children. Children age 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult or designated caretaker at all times. Parties responsible, must remain with the child(ren) at all times. Being added to a family membership as a babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker does not give that person a membership. The babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker must be with at least one child listed on the membership referenced above, in order to enter the pool. The Board of Directors may amend these rules at any time.

Membership certificates (bonds) must be transferred through the Association. Before purchasing a bond from a member, contact the board to ensure that the bond is in good standing. Yearly dues must be paid each year, regardless of whether or not you use the begin pool. If dues are not paid, a lien will be placed



on the bond. Dues are not transferable. It is the members responsibility to sell their bond or relinquish it back to the pool before the start of the pool season if they do not intend to use it, to avoid a lien being placed on the bond.

Complaints about pool operation can be submitted to a member of the Board of Directors or sent to PLPoolOmaha@gmail.com for review and consideration.

No toy squirt guns or water guns are allowed in the main pool at any time. Do not bring them in, or they will be confiscated. **Any ball used to play catch must be soft in nature, and not made of a hard surface that can cause injury to anyone struck by it. Footballs are not allowed in the pool**.

POOL CLEAN-UP DATES APRIL 2024

Every 4 hours of work earns a \$50 rebate.

Volunteers **MUST** check in with a board member in order to receive credit for volunteering. A sign-up sheet will be available in the office.

Detailed notifications, including times and tasks, will be posted on social media and emailed soon. Volunteers generally start at 9:00 or 10:00 am on the weekends.
