

2019 Prairie Lane Pool Dues Notice

- **Family Membership: \$435.00 (Must own bond)**
 - * **Parent(s) and minor children; 3 or more family members.**
- **2P Membership: \$235.00 (Must own bond)**
 - * Any 2 people. Examples: 1 parent and 1 child, 1 grandparent and 1 grandchild, 2 adults.
- **Trial Membership: \$435.00** (Bond requirement waived for 1 year only)
 - * Parent(s) and minor children.
- The price of a bond purchased from the pool is \$200. Bond payments can be split over 2 years.
- *All memberships are for persons living in one household*
- Bonds purchased from members must be in good standing. Email the pool for verification.

- The pool will open Friday, May 24th. At 5:00pm. Members are not permitted to swim until dues are paid in full.
- Guest passes will not be available until dues are paid in full.
- Payments made after May 24th will accrue a \$15 late fee.
