Sign-up for swim lessons and swim team will be available in the office any time during normal hours as soon as the pool is open.

Notifications for early closings for swim meets or inclement weather will be communicated via email, social media, and text alert.

<u>Please have a plan of action and a designated place for unaccompanied</u> <u>children to go, near the pool if the weather changes unexpectedly</u>.

Pool Rules

These rules are for the protection and benefit of all members of the Prairie Lane Association, Inc. Their purpose is to assure safe, sanitary, and fun-filled operation of our pool.

PARENTS please explain these rules to your children and insist that your children observe them. The Pool Manager has the authority to suspend any member of the Association for a period of up to 10 days for violating these rules. Continued or flagrant violations will lead to cancellation of membership.

Swim Team

Cost for the swim team will be \$50.00 for the first Swimmer, and \$45.00 for the second swimmer, with a maximum of \$135.00 per family. You must be a member of the pool to be on PL swim team. Swim team practices are scheduled to begin the last week of May with the first meet to be held in early June. Swimming finals will be in mid-July. Swim meets hosted at Prairie Lane need many Volunteers. Swim Team parents are expected to

sign up to volunteer a minimum of two swim meets, please be sure to sign up when you register your child for swim team.

NOTE

Child must have passed Level 4 of swim lessons or equivalent, and be able to swim one continuous length of the pool to be a member of swim team.

Swim Lessons

Cost for a two-week session will be \$45.00 for a Member, and \$60.00 for a non-member. Three sessions will be offered during the following weeks: June 1 – June 12

June 22 – July 3 July 13 – July 24 Each session consists of ten, thirty-minute lessons. Starting times offered at 10:15, 10:50 and 11:25 am.



Pool Rules

<u>SWIMMING</u>

The pool will be open from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM Sunday through Saturday, except when closed for special events. The pool will remain closed, or will close, when the reported temperature is below 70. If temperatures reach 70 by 3:00PM or 5:00 PM, the pool will open. Please watch for announcements, or feel free to call, to confirm that the pool is open.

Weekday mornings are reserved for swim team practices and group swim lessons. An adult or an older child (10 or older) must accompany children 7 years of age and younger to the pool. The wading pool is for children 5 years and under, every child must have adult supervision with them in the baby pool area. Diaper-age children must wear tight-fitting, waterproof pants. Children who have not passed the basic swimming test will be restricted to the intermediate wading area of the main pool, unless accompanied by a parent. Running, pushing, wrestling, snapping towels or causing other undue disturbances will not be permitted in the pool or on the deck. All diving shall be done off the end of the diving board. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. Diving from the edge of the pool is not permitted in the diving area. Swimming is not allowed in the diving area, except to leave the diving area, it must be done immediately. Upon request of a lifeguard, all swimmers must immediately get out of the water. Inflatable and Styrofoam objects are prohibited, except in the wading pool. NO EXCEPTIONS. The Pool Manager has discretion to institute other necessary rules.

<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>

The Association is not responsible for accidents or injury to members or guests. The Association is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property. Facilities for checking clothing or valuables are not available. The only cash required will be that to pay guest fees and concessions. Adult members are responsible for their children and guests. Damage to any Association property will be charged to the member family, or if by a guest, to the adult registering the guest.

SANITATION

No food or drinks allowed with-in 4 feet of the pool edge. This includes the wading pool. No pets allowed inside the bathhouse or on the pool deck. No person shall be permitted to use the pool without first taking a warm shower in the nude using soap.

No person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, cut, sore or lesion: eye, ear, nose or throat infection shall be admitted to the pool area. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, and any other similar activities are prohibited in the pool.

No running, boisterous or rough play shall be permitted in the pool, on the walkways, diving board, or in the pool area.

Absolutely no glass containers allowed on pool deck or in pool area. Includes inside a cooler. NO EXCEPTIONS. No smoking allowed in pool area.

Guests

Guest privileges are not extended to anyone residing in the area bounded by: Interstate 680 on the east: 120th Street on the west: West Center Street on the north: and the Union Pacific tracks on the south. Each member family is allowed admission privileges for guests residing outside of this area. An adult member must register all guests.

Guest fees are \$5.00 per day. House Guest: \$10.00 per week. House guests Family: \$20.00 per week. Houseguests are those people visiting you, who reside outside the Omaha metropolitan area. All fees are payable at the time of registration. Any special guest situation must be presented to the Board of Directors in writing.



Guest Passes

Take advantage of our referral bonus! Encourage friends & neighbors to join the pool. For information about a Prospective Membership guest pass, contact any Board Member listed above.

Guest Passes will be held at the front desk, on a guest sheet with the guards. This will allow members the freedom from keeping track of guest passes as well as saving paper.

Guest cannot live within the neighborhood boundaries. Please respect this rule, violators will be asked to leave.

General

The board voted to allow members paying the full price Family Membership to add a babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker for their children. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult or designated caretaker at all times. Parties responsible, must remain with the child(ren) at all times. Being added to a family membership as a babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker does not give that person a membership. The babysitter, nanny, or designated caretaker must be with at least one child listed on the membership referenced above, in order to enter the pool. The Board of Directors may amend these rules at any time. Membership certificates (bonds) must be transferred through the Association.



Before purchasing a bond from a member, contact the board to ensure that the bond is in good standing. All maintenance fees (dues) must be paid each year, regardless of whether or not you use the pool. If not paid, a lien will be placed on your bond. Maintenance fees are not transferable.

Complaints about pool operation can be submitted to a member of the Board of Directors or sent to PLPoolOmaha@gmail.com for review and consideration.

NO cameras or cell phones are allowed in the restroom areas.

No toy squirt guns or water guns are allowed in the main pool at any time. Do not bring them in, or they will be confiscated. Any ball used to play catch must be soft in nature, and not made of a hard surface that can cause injury to anyone struck by it.
