McCoullough shared with us the graduation pictures of eight young men who graduated from the Bible College and will soon be starting churches there in the Congo (pictured below). We will not only help those eight men start churches, but we were also blessed to help Pastor Ezekiel Ibrahim, in Nigeria, to purchase land for \$1500 to build his church on. God is opening so many doors for the Outreach to step through and be of service to those spreading the Gospel!

We have had many reports from Bro. Rick Martin in the Philippines. Bro. Martin shared the story of a female staff member treated unkindly by a particular family in the area. When a storm took the family's home, the staff member gathered a group to work and rebuild the house. Because of the staffer's forgiving spirit, the family got saved and began to attend church. Bro. Martin gave that report, but he also asked that we be in prayer for the family of Pastor Adonis Motol, who died of a snake bite. Pastor Motol faithfully served the Lord for 24 years.

Pastor Jorel Rana, also in the Philippines, held a Youth Fellowship on God-Honoring Relationships for the youth (pictured below). He used the meeting to encourage them, when choosing a mate, to always keep God first, choose wisely, and stay pure. The pastors realize the importance of reaching the youth and keeping them close to God. Bro. Jonathan Luceno holds ukulele lessons for the children. He started with five students, and it has grown to fifteen. He also has five students who use recorder flutes. He said that he is honored to teach something so simple, but it can be used to change the children's lives and encourage them to serve God (pictured below).

We received word that Bro. Khampi in Thailand needed \$1500 for his well this month. Through the faithfulness of those who support us, we were able to send him the money. There are many needs to be met each month. Many of the men we support cannot publicly announce they are Christians or let their needs be known for fear of imprisonment or death. In America, we are extremely blessed. We can proudly proclaim His truth without fear of retribution.

We are very excited to help with a new project in Alaska. We are building a Missionary Survival Training School. Many missionaries go to Alaska but have no idea how to survive or navigate the difficult terrain and meet the needs of the indigenous people who live there. The school will train these men in every area they will need to have a productive ministry.

I would greatly appreciate your prayers this month as I travel to visit Missionary Kevin Wynne in Mexico City. I am honored to have Pastor Billy Sechrist, my sending pastor, travel with me, along with two others. Pray for our safety and for our trip to be beneficial in whatever way the Lord has for us.

Once again, I thank each of you who support the Outreach, whether through financial means or prayer. We could never see souls saved, build churches, or continue to spread the Gospel without you.
