I am grateful to receive the reports each month and hear about all the ministries we support. These men and women are working hard to win as many souls to Christ as possible. Not only are they winning souls, but they are discipling, building, and growing Christian homes and lives. Bro. Luke Deschamp in Chandler, Arizona, is excited to see his new converts bringing folks to church! He is holding Bible classes to help teach those who have never been taught the Word of God. In just the past three months, he has seen 34 accept Christ and had 8 baptisms in his church. He is thrilled to be in his new building. Seeing God work and grow these church plants is such a blessing!

Bro. Todd Painter, in Thailand, reported this month on a Buddhist man who has attended his church for two years. Every time Hell was preached on, the man would leave and hide in the restroom until Bro. Painter finished. After witnessing his unsaved aunt pass away, he knew he did not want to share the same fate as her. He immediately called on Jesus to save him! Two years of hearing the Gospel finally got through to him. (pictured below)

We also received a report from the refugee camp in Nigeria. The City of Refuge currently has 11 families with a total of 14 children living at the camp. These people have accepted Jesus into their hearts, but because of it, they have been rejected by their people. The camp provides a home for them where they can be taught how to live for the Lord. The camp is doing well, but has many needs. Please pray they find the support to build a kitchen. They are currently cooking meals under a mango tree on the property. (last picture below)

This month has thankfully been a busy one! We were blessed to send \$3000 to the Baptist Heritage Children's Home in Nigeria, to help get their bathrooms up to code for federal inspections. We sent \$4000 to help start a bus ministry at Amazing Grace Baptist Church in Missouri, and we started support to Bro. Robert Mickey's college in Kenya. We also took on two men in Middle Eastern countries, and in the midst of it all, we held a Tent Revival in Mexico, Missouri, where we saw nine souls accept Christ! (pictured below)

I was blessed this month to be with Pastor JV Elswick and the Twin Rivers Baptist Church in New Bern, NC, for their Homecoming service, where 22 came forward for salvation during the morning service. I preached for Pastor Brian Tatum in Council Bluffs, Iowa, this past week for their Friends' Day service. We had 16 accept Christ as their personal Savior.

I am so thankful the Lord continues to use me to help plant churches, encourage Pastors, and most importantly, spread the Gospel. Please pray that we will continue to keep going and "faint not".
