The Congo presents significant challenges for spreading the Gospel due to governmental restrictions and a sizable Muslim population.

Bro. Robert Mickey, who is based in Kenya, recently shared an encouraging report about the work he is doing in the Congo. The Congolese pastors he works with have started distributing copies of the translated John/Romans. These pastors have reported that Muslims in their region are eagerly accepting the Word of God.

Bro. Mickey remarked on their reception of the books, saying, "They do not realize that a seed is being planted each time they read the Word of God." Please pray that as they read, the Lord will soften their hearts, leading them to accept His saving grace.

We are excited to welcome two new church plants for support this month: Bro. Thomas Blecher and Bro. Steven Barnes, who have both started churches in Guam. Additionally, we have taken on four new individuals who are starting churches in Mexico.

We kindly ask for your prayers for the men we support in the Middle East. These are very challenging times in that region, and they would greatly appreciate your prayers for their ministries and safety.

The Outreach has recently expanded to include new plants in the United States. Brother Leejay Richards in Illinois and Brother Daniel Miller in Arkansas have both established new churches. We were able to assist in purchasing carpet for Brother Miller's building. It is a great honor to support these men as they build their ministries for the Lord.

I am truly honored to play a small role in witnessing God's work through the Outreach. The numerous reports from around the world are incredibly exciting. God is using the RMMO as a tool for building His Kingdom. Through His power and blessings, the millions of souls we have reached will one day be with Him for all eternity!
