We like to share the numbers, not for bragging rights on us, but to brag on the Lord and how He is blessing the ministry and the pastors we support. God is still in the saving business!

All of our pastors have been working hard to build their churches. With God's help, many are not only seeing souls saved, but higher attendance and the start of new areas of ministry. Bro. Andrew Merritt in New York not only braved the cold and snowy conditions to continue going door to door but also took part in sending King James Bibles to be distributed to all New York legislators. Bro. Todd Herbert, at the Winning Side Baptist Church in Arizona, saw 329 men saved with a group in the jail ministry. Our American church plants may not face the hardships of foreign fields, but they still need the courage to keep going when it seems their church is not growing. They covet our prayers!

Our foreign pastors have been hard at work to grow and strengthen their ministries as well. One of our men had a medical missions outreach. Doctors from the States came to their church on a mission trip. While there they examined and treated seventy children and thirty-four adults. What a blessing to have this type of ministry to help those in need. They not only received physical care, but Spiritual care as well. Bro. Samson Adams, in West Africa, reported a trip into a prison while on a mission trip himself. While there, he preached to eighty prisoners in Langtang and forty made professions of salvation. The men may be held as prisoners today but because someone had the courage to go in and tell them about Jesus, they are free for all eternity from the awful place called Hell!

We were also excited to hear about the humble beginning of the Iloilo Bible College from Missionary Rick Martin. (pictured below) The college began in 1978 in an old house with thirteen full-time students. Today hundreds attend and ninety percent of those who graduate start a new church within three to four months of graduation. We support Bro. Martin and through his graduates, we have planted twenty-two churches. We are honored to help these men get their churches up and running quickly. People need salvation, but they also need to be discipled in God's Word.

Please continue to pray for our orphanage in the Congo, there have been some delays, but it will soon be finished. Pray also for Bro. Todd Painter who is in Thailand, that he will find a new translator/pastor to help in the chartering of his ministry. He was honored to have his son visit and go out soulwinning with him. (pictured below) His son pastors Bro. Painters former church. Also, Bro. Robert Jones in South Africa, asks that we pray for the funds to purchase a new van. A van will enable him to pick up more people to bring to the church.
