We are so honored to help Pastors "build" their buildings, "build" their ministries, and "build" their congregations, but at the end of the day, all of our work is vain if the Lord is not in it. He builds all things, and only through Him will we see growth. We are thrilled to see the Lord use men to build churches all over the world physically, but more importantly, we are thrilled to see Him build churches spiritually, with the power of the Gospel to lead souls to accept Him as their Savior!

Through the dedicated work of the men we support, great things are happening! This month, our cargo container for the orphanage finally set sail for delivery (pictured). It was amazing to see the reports of the container being filled with all the supplies needed to finish the orphanage. The last delivery of supplies will allow those children in the Congo to become one step closer to moving into their new home.

As we plant churches across the country and the world, a building or place to gather is a priority. We have "built" churches in many interesting places. I was recently in Craig, Colorado, with Pastor Williams, whose church is in an old bank building (pictured). We faced many struggles getting this church up and running, but now it is thriving and growing! While I was there, they had their biggest attendance to date. We praise the Lord for 17 of those who came and accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Another building, which is now the home of the Genesis Baptist Church, in Wilburton, Ok, was being used as a drug house. We rejoice that one young man, who at one time crashed there to do drugs, has gotten saved and is serving the Lord in the very same building! We have also purchased a former Minneonite church, and it will now become an Independent Baptist Church reaching souls for Christ.

We find that many times, pastors do not even have a building, and God still builds their work. One of our Congo pastors started under a mango tree last year with three in attendance. This year, they have a building and celebrated the one-year anniversary with 180 in attendance. God worked, and 35 of those who came to their anniversary service asked the Lord to save them. A building without the saved is just a building.

Many of our church buildings do not have baptismal pools, but that does not stop God from providing a way. In our tent ministry, we use a cow trough! Pastor Kirby Campbell is meeting in a temporary spot and praying for a building. While they wait, he uses a local swimming pool when the weather is warm to baptize. Bro. Jeff Walters, who pastors in the inner city of Dallas/Fort Worth, held a special Baptism Service at an apartment complex. The service was outdoors, and he also used a metal cow trough. (pictured). He had 84 in attendance, and 27 were baptized that day. Bro. Walters said the Lord was providing "light in a dark place". The inner city is full of gangs and violence, but those evil forces cannot stop God from building and rebuilding lives!

There are so many amazing stores sent to us through monthly reports. Bro. Stephen Simmons works hard to help print tracts in Mexico City. One of the workers, Carlos, has been an invaluable help in printing thousands of Gospel tracts. Through those tracts, many have been saved. But Carlos was not. He was helping to print a message that would lead thousands to the Lord, but had never accepted Him into his own heart. Bro. Simmons asked him if he had even read the material he was printing. Carlos could not say that he had. After speaking with Carlos and explaining the Gospel to him, Bro. Simmons was blessed to lead Carlos to the Lord.

There are so many wonderful reports of the work being done. I cannot begin to express my thankfulness to God for using the Outreach to make a difference in the building of His kingdom. Many will spend eternity in Heaven because of the faithfulness and service of others. Your continued prayers and support are what continue to keep the Outreach going, and we are truly thankful.

I do ask for your prayers as I am traveling to Alaska to meet with a group about starting a wilderness survival training school. The school will teach missionaries how to survive in the Alaskan bush and how to communicate with the natives who live there.
