We were excited to receive an update from the Baptist Heritage Orphanage and the City of Refuge in Nigeria. The Refuge now accommodates 13 families. We are happy to hear the children at the orphanage are doing wonderfully. They recently had a fantastic Christmas party filled with gifts, and they proclaimed it the "Best Christmas Ever!"
