I am so thankful for all of those who work diligently to support the Ron Middleton Missions Outreach. Together we are building a great work for the Lord. There have been over six million souls saved since our beginning in January of 2020. We are God's people and He is working through us all to reach souls for the cause of His precious Son, Jesus. We are extremely thankful for God's mercy and grace.

I wanted to thank everyone who prayed for the Tent Revials we had scheduled for the month. Unfortunately, both tent meetings were canceled, but I was able to go alone to New Orleans and help the pastor. We went out in his area soulwinning, held meetings, and saw souls saved.

We are very excited about the Church in California and the work Pastor Tim Peterson is doing there. On their Anniversary Sunday there were fifty-six in attendance. Over the last two months the church has had twenty-five saved and eight baptisms. We look forward to hearing more about things the Lord is doing there.(Pictured first below)

We have also begun to support Brother Andrew Chafa. He is a Missionary out of Washington, Iowa. Brother Chafa puts up radio towers for different ministries. Radio and television ministries, especially in foreign countries are much needed. Missionary Mark Holmes, in Nigeria, over the last three years has presented seven weekly Gospel programs in six languages. Technology, when used correctly, can be a wonderful tool to reach the lost.

Bro. Holmes not only has his church, college, and audio/video ministry, but also the City of Refuge Home for those saved out of the Muslim faith. The home provides a safe place for those who have accepted Jesus to live without persecution. Currently twelve families, eight single men, and four staff live at the home. The Outreach was able to help them purchase a cow, rice, vegetables, and other items to help provide for their Christmas celebrations. This month we were also able to take on two new pastors in Nigeria. Please pray for their works as they begin to build their churches.

We are very excited to report our shipping container for the Congo Orphange will be leaving out mid December, barring any further delays. We have been waiting for the bunk beds to arrive. The container is filled with things to finish the orphanage, the Bible training center, and the radio station. The waterwell for the orphanage has been put down and the building is almost complete. (Pictured last below)God is helping us to build a very large work there in the Congo.

We were also able to help the orphanage in Nigeria this month with a special donation toward an extra house for the workers. The Nigerian government requires the workers to have separate housing. We were able to give \$4000 toward the project. We were also excited to get an update from one of the churches planted in the Congo (pictured center below). Pastor Zeke Ezriel is doing a great work there.

God is using the Outreach to do so many amazing things. We were able to help purchase a church bus, we took on four more men to plant churches in Mexico, began support to Bro. Biz Lerisse in the Dominican Republic, started support to help Bro. Liam Skogen start a church in Minnesota, and will be taking on more men in the Philippines for the first of the year.

God is truly blessing, and I am so thankful for His goodness to the Ron Middleton Missions Outreach!
