This past week the county issued their permit to expand the septic system on the house they purchased and are preparing. This will allow for double the enrollment. There is a waiting list due to the weekly calls of parents who need help for their daughters. We are honored to be apart of the ministry and ask you join us in praying for them.

We did get an update from Bro. Painter from the orphanages in Thailand. The Senior's Class at our home church, West Park Baptist, sent extra support this month. Bro.
