I want to thank everyone for all the prayers concerning my Philippine trip. Bro. Jonathan Brown and I had a wonderful time visiting with Missionary Rick Martin. We had the opportunity to preach at several of our church plants. While there, Bro. Jonathan was asked to preach to a group of the Philippine National Police(pictured first). There were 70 in attendance and over 40 accepted Christ. Throughout the trip we were honored to see 200 come to accept Christ!

We were also honored to meet Pastor Joeven Labana who is currently building a college(pictured middle). The college will be used to train new pastors to become church planters. The Outreach was honored to help with the project by sending \$2000. We give God all the glory in our ability to support the college. We realize the need for the college to be finished quickly so men can be trained and sent to win even more souls to the Lord. We plan to take on five new church plants in the coming months.

Bro. Aaron McCullough sent an update for the orphanage we are building in the Congo. A sixtyfoot cargo trailer has been purchased (pictured last). The trailer is being packed and will be shipped the first of November. It contains the roof, the water tower, and many other supplies needed to finish the home. We are so excited. We truly give God all the glory for working through the generous support given to the Outreach. With it, we can provide the children with a new home.

Bro. and Mrs. Thompson at the orphanage in Nigeria sent a great report, also. All the children were treated for Malaria and Typhoid and are doing great. Victory graduated and he is now going to attend Bible College. The Outreach has invested in these children and it is wonderful to see them continue to seek God and His will for their lives.

Many of the letters we received from Nigeria and the Philippines have told of the church plants holding Vacation Bible Schools, Summer Camps, and preaching in the government ran schools. Hundreds of children have been saved through the ministries we support. One pastor had 238 attend VBS and 47 were saved while another had 238 attend and 47 saved. The Gospel still works!

We ask you pray for the next Tent Revival. It will be held November 13-17 at the Faith Baptist Church in New Orleans. If you are in the area, please come by to join us.

I thank you for all of the prayers and support. We could never do what we do without each of you. All I can say is, "To God be the Glory, great things He hath done".
