Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for Bluecoats benefits, the safety officer must have been:

- ◆ A person providing police, fire, emergency medical or other emergency services.
- ◆ Family of deceased or totally disabled officer.
- ◆ State Troopers based in Medina County Post.

The family members of deceased safety officer eligible for Bluecoats benefits include a surviving spouse and dependent children. Bluecoats recognize that needs change over time as individuals and families mature. Each family is different, and Bluecoats does its very best to determine eligibility and appropriate benefits on a case by case basis.
