HUNGER NEVER TAKES A SUMMER VACATION

In the United States, approximately 22 million children rely on free or reduced -priced meals during the school year, yet only 2.7 million access free meals in the summer when school is out. In the six counties that make up the Diocese of Youngstown, 52% of our students are on a free or reduced-priced meal program during the school year. One out of five children in our six county service area is experiencing hunger or are at risk for hunger right now. Catholic Charities Summer Hunger Campaign will run from June 1st - August 31st to help fight the summer hunger problem in our Diocese. Our **Dollar Days Wish-List** is currently filled with pantry staples to help our local agencies support the **Summer Hunger Program**. This annual effort draws attention to the number of children who qualify for free or reduced breakfast and lunch during the school year, but may not have access to proper nutrition throughout the summer months when school is not in session.
