PASTORAL PLAN Following a lengthy and extensive consultation process, Bishop George V. Murry, S.J., has announced a new plan for pastoral regions for the six-county Youngstown Diocese. Under the plan, there will be 15 regions, to be made up of anywhere from five to as many as 11 of the current 87 parishes of the diocese. Within each region, parishes will collaborate on the best use of the available priests and parish staffs, the most advantageous scheduling of Masses and utilization of parish facilities, and how the parishes can best work together to serve the needs of the people within the region.

Warren City Parishes (4): St. Mary; St. Elizabeth Ann Seton; Blessed Sacrament; St. John Paul II.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. John Paul II will each have one Sunday Mass.

St. Mary and Blessed Sacrament will each have one Saturday Vigil and One Sunday Mass.

Recommend one Parish Leader for both St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. John Paul II

Timeline:

The plan for regionalization will be implemented by each region as soon as possible, and no later than July 1st, 2020. Full implementation in the region will include: Priests will be limited to 3 regularly scheduled weekend Masses, including the Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses. The number of weekend Masses in the region will equal the number in the plan and specific schedules will be determined in collaboration with all the parishes in the region. Regions will determine daily Mass and Holy Day schedules in collaboration with all the parishes in the region. Regions will have a concrete plan for, and actively working toward, collaboration in staff and ministry efforts. Regions will have a concrete plan for, and actively working toward, new evangelization initiatives in the region. The process for implementation within each region will be directed by the Deans with support and assistance from the Office of the Vicar for Clergy and the Office of Evangelization and Pastoral Planning. The Office of Evangelization and Pastoral Planning will monitor the implementation. One year after implementation, there will be an evaluation of each region.
