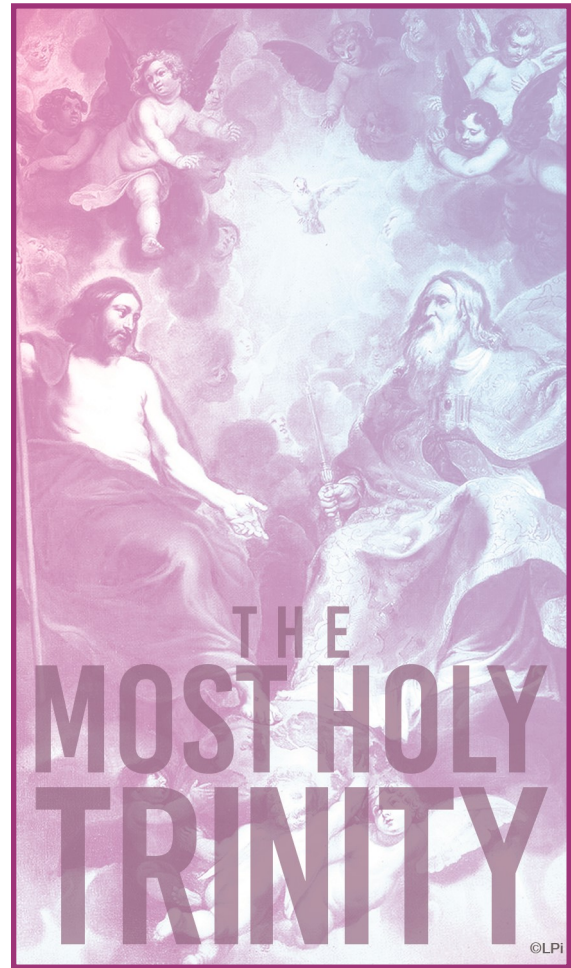

IN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS work will be starting to replace the roof at St. Mary's. During construction there will be equipment and scaffolding located around the church. Please use caution around this equipment. There may be times when an entrance is blocked due to the roofing activities. Please observe posted signs redirecting you to another entrance. Our spires and church roof are tall and steep, please pray for the safety of the workers as they perform their work.

The insurance money will cover the replacement of the roof shingles on the sanctuary and spires, but we are responsible for the cost of replacing the roofing on the flat roof portions, new plywood under the sanctuary shingles, and repairs to the lightning rod system. All Renovation and Restoration funds collected in 2019 will be used toward the new roof. Please give generously to help us preserve our past and build our future.

HUNGER NEVER TAKES A SUMMER VACATION

In the United States, approximately 22 million children rely on free or reduced-priced meals during the school year, yet only 2.7 million access free meals in the summer when school is out. In the six counties that make up the Diocese of Youngstown, 52% of our students are on a free or reduced-priced meal program during the school year. One out of five children in our six county service area is experiencing hunger or are at risk for hunger right now. Catholic Charities Summer Hunger Campaign will run from June 1st - August 31st to help fight the summer hunger problem in our Diocese.
