Rules and Regulations

As a public raffle, the Win a Week in Dublin Travel Raffle is open to all purchasers 18 years and over. 100% of proceeds support the Georgina Community Food Pantry.

The Draw for the A Week in Dublin (referred to from now on as Travel Voucher) will take place at the Georgina Link Hall at 20849 Dalton Road, Sutton West, On L0E 1R0 on April 6th 2019 at 9 pm.

The prize draw will select one (1) winner and that winning ticket is selected from the draw drum at random.

The Travel Voucher includes:

- Trip for two (2) to Dublin, Ireland for 1 week including roundtrip airfare from Toronto Pearson Airport, roundtrip transfer, accommodation and taxes
- Travel has a value of no more than \$5000 Canadian
- Transportation to and from airports (Toronto and Dublin) will be paid for by winner
- Travel Voucher must be accepted as offered;
- Travel must be booked by Uniglobe Donaldson Travel to claim prize
- Travel costs are valued up to \$5000 Canadian – remaining credit to be given towards spending money
- Winner is able to modify their package based upon their travel preferences. Due to fluctuations in travel pricing, all costs incurred above \$5000 are the sole responsibility of the winner.
- \$500 Canadian (cheque) in spending money provided shortly before departure

Tickets are personal and can only be in the name of one individual entrant

Prize will not be issued to anyone other than the one Individual entrant whose name is on the ticket.

By purchasing a ticket, you agree to allow us, The Georgina Community Food Pantry, the right, if you are the prize winner, to use and publicly disclose your name, municipality of residence, image, photograph and likeness as a prize winner in any means required by the terms of our lottery license and/or that we consider appropriate for purposes of administering and promoting the lottery, without notice, review or approval or additional compensation to you.

The name of the winner will be made available to the media and listed on the georginafoodpantry.ca website and Facebook page as well as in written and e-mail publications

Eligibility

The following individuals, all of their immediate family members and anyone residing in the same household are prohibited from purchasing a ticket: Georgina Community Food Pantry Board Members and Executive Director

Tickets

Ticket price/ Entry to raffle is \$25 each. The official ticket is a receipt of purchase. It is the responsibility of ticket purchasers to ensure that they receive their ticket/s; however, participants do not need their ticket/s in hand in order to be included in the draw. No refunds will be issued after purchase of the ticket.. Ticket purchases are not tax deductible.

The liability of the licensee of this lottery shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket.

Chances of Winning

Chances of winning are 1 in 1100. There will be 1100 tickets printed and numbered. Once these are sold, there are no further tickets available.

Draw

Winner will be randomly selected from all entries which are placed in the drum. Drum will be spun at least 3 rotations.

Prize Winner Notification

The winner will be notified by phone and/ or via email as to what they have won and where to claim their prize. The name of the winner will be posted to georginafoodpantry.com by April 10th.

Prize Claim

Prize will be awarded to the individual named on the official ticket. Prize notification email will be addressed to the primary ticketholder/ address provided on the ticket. It is the responsibility of the primary ticketholder to allocate the prize if necessary.

Prize winner is asked to claim prize in a timely manner following notification. The prize, if not claimed, shall be secured for a period of six (6) months from the date of the draw. Unclaimed prize will be reported, and a charitable allocation will be approved by the licensing body.
