The commitment:

Board members are expected to:

- Attend Board meetings which are usually held on the third Wednesday of each month, from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Meetings held in virtual format during the fall/winter months and in person in spring/summer.
- Participate in Board Committee and/or project work
- Attend annual events such as the AGM, strategic planning sessions and provide support at fundraising events
- In total, directors are expected to devote approximately ten hours per month of their time.
- Candidates must be willing to serve a 3-year term
