

OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity "30 Days of Christmas" Gun Giveaway Terms & Conditions

- 1. Limit of 1000 tickets to be distributed; numbering 000 to 999.
- 2. One ticket per \$30.00 donation.
- Ticket sales end on November 30th.
- 4. By obtaining a ticket, you attest that you are a law-abiding citizen of good moral character, may legally possess firearm(s) won, have the intention of using the firearm(s) only legally and safely, and will or have already obtained instruction on the safe use and operation of firearm(s) won.
- 5. Daily drawings will start on December 1st, and continue until December 30th. The Florida Lottery's Cash 3 Evening drawing will determine each day's winning number.
- 6. All firearms won are subject to availability, and the OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity reserves the right to substitute firearms of equal or greater value.
- 7. Proceeds of the "30 Days of Christmas" benefit OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity, Inc., a Florida 501 (3) (c) non-profit charity.
- 8. An OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity representative will notify AA Tactical of the nightly winner. An AA Tactical representative will contact the winner to arrange for the pickup of the firearm won.
- 9. You must be at least 21 years old and a legal resident of the United States to obtain a ticket and collect any firearm(s) won in the giveaway.
- 10. Prizes are not transferable. The person designated on the ticket must claim the prize.
- 11. Winners will be notified using the name, address, and/or phone number the purchaser has written or requested to be on the ticket stub. In the event the OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity/AA Tactical is unable to contact the winner, it is the sole responsibility of the winning ticket holder to contact the OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity/AA Tactical to claim their prize. Prizes are not transferable; the person designated on the ticket must claim the prize. ALL PRIZES MUST BE CLAIMED AND TRANSFER COMPLETED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE SCHEDULED DATE THE TICKET IS DRAWN.
- 12. All Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms (ATF) rules apply.
- 13. All firearm transfers will be made through a Federally Licensed (FFL) dealer, and all applicable Federal and State Laws will apply, including the state laws for the legal residence of the winning ticket holder.
- 14. Winners will be responsible for applicable Federal, State, and local taxes.
- 15. Transfers will be made by AA Tactical, located at 451 N. Ferdon Boulevard, Crestview, Florida. The OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity solely reserves the right to change the location and/or dealer for any transfer. The winning ticket holder must make the transfer through the OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity's selected dealer and in accordance with all applicable laws.
- 16. In the event winner needs or wishes to have the firearm(s) won transferred to a local FFL dealer closer to their residence, shipping and any other additional costs involved with the transfer will be the responsibility of the winner, and arrangements will be made directly with AA Tactical or another Charity-selected FFL dealer.
- 17. Winners may be required to verify that ownership of the firearm(s) won is legal in their state, city, or town before taking possession of won prize(s).
- 18. Winning ticket numbers are eligible for the remaining drawings. All sold or unsold 1000 ticket numbers are in each drawing. (You can win more than once per ticket). No prizes will be awarded on unsold ticket numbers drawn.
- 19. The OCSO Sheriff's Star Charity will not take possession of any firearm(s) involved in this giveaway; winners will receive the firearm(s) directly from an FFL dealer only. All applicable state and federal laws apply.
