When again they had to venture into the storm, Sandy prayed, "Lord, lead Dustin and me." As they walked, snow stung their faces. When Dustin whined a little, Sandy said, "It's okay boy, the Lord is with us." ...

Public Safety Reminder


School is back in session. Watch for Kids and buses on the way to and from school.
