## **IFS Installation Options**

Hi Folks,

Many have shared that they are not able to self install the IFS filter system for whatever reason. We understand that and can only share the following facts with you.

The manufacture repair facilities have no intention to endorse the IFS system. Why? Because it is not "Endorsed". Why? Excellent question.

Let's say you sell sprinkler water pumps for a living and every time the water pump failed the valves that controlled all the sprinkler heads would plug up with pump debris and the customer had to buy all new sprinkler heads and a new pump from you, would you "endorse" a product that would protect your sprinkler heads? (an honest man would) You sell a new pump for \$250.00 BUT the valves sell for an additional \$50.00 each and the customer has 6 of them! Then, you also charge \$900.00 to dig up and replace the six valves. That \$250.00 pump now cost the customer \$1,450.00.

This is in no way insinuating that any business operates that way, it is up to the consumer to decide that perception.

Back to Installation Options. Many diesel repair shops will install IFS. Some customers have actually hired mechanic s that "moonlight" to make a few extra bucks.
