Readers will not be provided. Introductory Dressage, Working Equitation, Western Dressage, and Eventing Tests for Entry, Pretraining, and Training levels will be ridden in small arena. We

will run two Test of Choice Classes per level. Tests being ridden *must be* indicated on entry.

Placings will be presented 1st to 5th per class regardless of test ridden. When there is only one horse in a class, ribbons and prizes shall be awarded in accordance with the following chart of percentages: 1st - 60% or higher 2nd - 57% to 59.9% 3rd - 54% to 56.9% 4th - 51% to 53.9%

Please note that preference is given to riders from barns who are also competing on Sunday.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Hunter Derby Judges evaluate the horse's jumping style, rideability, and overall presentation. Judges use an open-scoring system, rating each horse out of 100. Judges add points for high-option fences (no Options in Ground Poles or Crossrail Divisions). Judges deduct points for mistakes like missed lead changes, knocked rails, and imperfect distances. Judges consider the horse's technique, style, accuracy, consistency, and pace. What's included bending lines, fences with long approaches, a trot fence, rollbacks, and tight turns. Ground Pole and Crossrail Courses may be trotted or cantered. No penalties for simple lead changes in 1'6" and 2'0" Division.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. EC rules and regulations will be followed.

Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees. Abuse includes, but is not restricted to, excessive use of spurs, abuse of the whip and brutal use of the reins during halts or rein backs, repeated tugs on the horse's mouth. Excessive use of the whip: the whip cannot be used to vent a rider's temper. Such use is always excessive. The whip is not to be used after elimination or after a horse has jumped the last fence on a course. The whip is never to be used overhand, (e.g. a whip in the right hand being used on the left flank). The use of a whip on a horse's head is always excessive use. A horse should never be hit more than three times for any one incident. If a horse's skin is broken, it is considered excessive use of the whip.

All riders must be members of Alberta Equestrian Federation.

We follow the Equine Vaccination Rule "All horses must have been administered Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (1 and 4) vaccinations within six (6) months (+21 days grace period) before arrival at the competition. No horse shall have received vaccination within seven (7) days prior to arrival at the event. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be asked to leave event site at the discretion of competition management."

The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.

Management reserves the right to change the class order, if necessary, after the close of entries. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to determine when their classes will be judged. A rough schedule will be posted on our social media channels prior to the show.

Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to determine when their class will be judged. A gate hold will prevail as a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that they are **on time for their classes.** For performance classes once judging has commenced no one will be allowed in show ring. **No refunds for exhibitors who miss their class**.

Exhibitors are responsible for making correct entries, **NO REFUND** for entry fee will be made for **classes incorrectly** entered.

Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a trainer, groom, handler/rider / parent and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.

Exhibitors cancelling their entries after the official closing date, but prior to show shall, upon presentation of vet certificate, forfeit admin fees but will see other fees refunded. If cancelling after official closing date and Thursday prior to show, upon presentation of vet certificate will forfeit admin and stabling fees. Entries cancelled day of show shall forfeit entries, admin, and stabling fees. Certain circumstances we may transfer entries to another show at the discretion of show committee.

We recommend that maximum two divisions entered per horse plus chosen flat class if doing so. Consecutive divisions if riding one ring or similar height divisions if riding both. ie 0.60m and 0.70m jumper or 0.60m jumper and 2'0 hunter. We suggest entering one division prior to entry deadline and adding at show if you are not sure (no late entry fee).

Stabling is available on a limited basis and includes first bedding. Stabling available Friday to Sunday \$60 per night or for day stall only. Small Pens for 1 or 2 horses and Large Pens for 2 or 3 horses is also available at \$30 and \$40 per pen per night or per day use only.

No judge shall be approached regarding any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety and no entry fees will be refunded. This is applicable not only to riders, but coaches, representatives, or friends and family members of riders.

The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance. Should a fall occur where a concussion or injury can reasonably be suspected competitors must have medical clearance by onsite qualified medical personnel before continuing to compete.

Show photographer may be onsite.

Dogs must always be on a leash.

Schooling rounds will be available day prior in both rings. Times will be made available for booking until 4pm unless by special arrangement to go later. Schooling passes available at \$25 per rider. These will be in half hour increments unless large group. Single riders may be grouped with other single riders.

Ribbons will be presented to 5th place.

Shamrock Series Championship points will be awarded in each class of a Hunter/Jumper Divisions May through July as follows: 1st place - 6 points, 2nd place - 4 points, 3rd place - 3 points, 2nd place - 2 points, and 5th place - 1 point. In the event of a tie the highest placing in

the largest prize money class will be used. Division Champion Prize will be given at each show. Grand Champion and Grand Reserve Champion will be awarded at the final show in July with culmination of points from all three shows.

Points to be awards as follows: 1 point for each class entered. Placing points as above. Should there be no placing we will go by scores on judges cards.

Classes where prize money is awarded, prize money shall be split as follows: 1st: 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%.
