<u>PAYMENTS:</u> The down payment is placed to hold a particular cat for a buyer. This is 25% of the total purchase price. All down payments are <u>non-refundable</u>, since holding for one buyer could jeopardize the chance for the cat to be sold to someone else. This money does go towards the final price of your pet. The remaining amount of the purchase price is to be paid 1 week before the date of pick-up/delivery (unless paying cash at pick-up.) Under <u>NO</u> circumstances will we allow a cat to leave our cattery without the entire balance being paid and this contract signed!

Forms of payment include: <u>Cash</u> (works best when a cat is being picked up) or <u>Paypal</u> (friends & family).

<u>OPTIONAL PRE-PURCHASE EXAM:</u> Buyer may choose to request a health certificate with full blood panel test prior to completion of this sale. This would be done at the <u>Buyer's expense of \$200</u>. **These charges must be paid upfront and are non-refundable, regardless of results.** Please note: this is in addition to the non-refundable deposit of 20% of cat price required to hold a specific cat for the Buyer.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- 1. You agree to never declaw this cat. If you do, the contract is void.
- 2. You must contact us first before getting rid of your cat.
- 3. You also agree to annual vet check-ups.
- 4. You will receive weekly updates (pictures/videos) of your cat after you pay a deposit.

FUTURE EXPENSES: The Buyer assumes responsibility for all expenses of the cat after they leave the possession of the Seller. Examples of these expenses will include: high protein cat food preferably with no grains or fillers, litter box needs, toys and activities to keep your energetic cat busy, veterinary costs for both expected (i.e. vaccinations) and unexpected treatments (i.e. injury, illness etc.) If, for any reason, the cat is returned to the Seller, the Buyer agrees to pay all expenses including: delivery or pick-up costs such as mileage, air fare and re-examination expense by Seller's veterinarian. This examination will include a complete "viral panel" blood test for FELV, FIP and FIV viruses. If cat is returned to Seller for resale on behalf of the Buyer, the terms of this resale will be agreed upon under separate written agreement.

<u>SHIPPING COSTS</u>: All shipping costs are to be **prepaid by the Buyer** along with final payment. Shipping costs usually include airfare for the person accompanying the cat, carry-on charges from the airline and an airline-approved carrier of suitable size and could occasionally include accommodations in the event of: flight delay or cancellation, rerouting or missed connections. The Buyer would then need to provide for overnight stay at a motel or hotel that allows pets.

DELIVERY FEE:

If Seller agrees to meet a potential Buyer to deliver a cat, a fee of \$1/ mile will be expected **upfront and is non-refundable** if the Buyer chooses not to take the cat of interest.

ROOM AND BOARD: If the cat being sold can not be picked up/delivered within a week of the deposit, an additional fee of \$20/week for room and board will be added to purchase price. This is due to the cost of food, litter, time and energy it takes to properly care for each cat.

LIMITED HEALTH GUARANTEE: AllSpottedUp Cattery guarantees the health of your kitten until he/she reaches ONE YEAR OF AGE. The Seller's health guarantee will offer another kitten, of equal or lesser value, as replacement in the event said kitten should die as a direct result of an unknown (at the time of sale) congenital birth defect, or be diagnosed with a terminal genetic defect where the cat expires in the first 12 months of life. Seller also warrants kitten against FIP (unless FIP vaccination is given). An appropriate necropsy must be performed by a licensed veterinarian and a veterinarian's certificate with full disclosure and a copy of this report is provided as proof of cause of death. In addition, the veterinarian must send a sample of the cat's DNA to UC Davis AND submit a signed photograph of the cat to Seller, for confirmation that the cat IS the same cat covered by this purchase agreement. Any evidence of trauma, abuse, neglect, not receiving proper nutrition, failure to obtain veterinary care and not providing required documentation, will void the opportunity for replacement. There shall be no refunds of holding fee, purchase price, shipping charges or other costs. Shipping expenses of the replacement kitten will also be the responsibility of the Buyer.

We recommend that you take the kitten to your own veterinarian (at Buyer's expense) within 3 days. This time period begins when the kitten leaves the possession of the Seller. You or your veterinarian shall immediately report to the Seller any medical problem found within this period. **Failure to notify Seller within one business day will void this warranty.** If the kitten is found to be in "unsound health" by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours, the kitten shall be returned to Seller and Buyer may request a replacement. Said replacement will be made as soon as a suitable replacement becomes available. A medical report signed by the examining veterinarian must be provided to the Seller prior to a replacement being made. "Unsound health" shall be defined as: any condition which is "life threatening" or "incurable" but shall **not** include "curable" conditions or infections including but not limited to "colds, virus, bacterial/parasitic infections or allergies."

It is a well-known fact that the immune system of kittens can decrease dramatically when they are under stress from being in a new environment and leaving their family behind. It takes at least 2 weeks for the immune system to fully rebound. So it is VITAL for the kitten to be confined and NOT exposed to other animals because while in a weakened condition, the kitten may be prone to catching illnesses carried by other animals, that may not be exhibiting any symptoms. Also, if the kitten does break with an illness, it is important not to expose the Buyer's other animals to whatever the new kitten may have acquired. Therefore, it is *imperative* that you place the new arrival in quarantine for a minimum of one week. **Exposure to other animals of any species during this time will void this warranty.**

<u>VACCINATIONS</u>: A copy of our veterinary care records will be sent with your pet on departure day. Please share this with your local vet during your initial check up. Many breeders and veterinarians do not consider FELV and/or FIP vaccines safe. It is imperative that you have your vet perform a complete blood panel for exposure to these diseases *before* you vaccinate your animal against either of them. We recommend you discuss with your vet to consider the risk factors before vaccinating for Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP). **Should you choose to use this vaccine, your kitten's entire health guarantee will be voided.** If there are special circumstances in your household, such as an indoor/outdoor cat that may expose your animal to Feline Leukemia or a cat already in the household that is positive for the disease, vaccination for FELV (Feline Leukemia vaccine) may be done if your vet recommends it. **Unnecessary use of this vaccine will also void the health warranty.**
