
This annual event is a spiritual retreat centered on our God-gifted creativity.

Camp is located 7 miles northeast of Petersburg, PA. It is nestled five miles into the Rothrock State Forest on Diamond Valley Rd.

Coming from Petersburg, turn left on Diamond Valley Rd (1/4 mile east of Petersburg). Follow Diamond Valley Rd into Rothrock State Forest. Camp is located approx. 5 miles into the forest.

Coming from State College, follow Rt. 26, from Pine Grove Mills, over the mountain. Turn right onto Chartered Oak Road located at the bottom of the mountain. Follow Chartered Oak through Mooresville; turn right on Globe Run Rd. Follow Globe Run into the state forest which leads directly to camp.

Coming from Lewistown, or Belleville, follow Route 305 into Mooresville, turn left, then follow the directions above using Globe Run Rd.
