Pay What You Can For Camp

Camp Blue Diamond is committed to making sure every child has the opportunity to participate in the life changing experience that comes with spending time at a Christian summer camp. We know that the lessons learned at summer camp can have an impact that goes well beyond the time a camper will spend at Camp Blue Diamond. This is truly a mountain top experience.

New for summer 2023 we are introducing a tiered pricing structure that ensures every child has the opportunity to come to Camp Blue Diamond while allowing those that are able to support camp in a new way by paying a fee that more closely reflects the true amount that is costs to continue the ministries of Camp Blue Diamond. For each camp, you will notice 3 different fees listed. Please choose the fee that most closely reflects your family's ability to support the ministry of Camp Blue Diamond.

<u>Standard Fee:</u> This fee allows families, no matter their financial means, an opportunity for their child to experience camp. This fee is the same price or lower than in 2022.

<u>Supporter's Fee:</u> This fee allows families that are able to pay a cost that more accurately reflects the actual cost of



summer camp. This helps cover often overlooked costs, such as, insurance, vehicle and building maintenance, utilities, replacing equipment and more.

<u>Sustainer's Fee:</u> This fee allows us to keep the standard fee as affordable as possible. We are also able to cover all those overlooked costs plus we will be able to offer our summer staff a more competitive wage for the Christ like example they provide during the summer.

We encourage each family to pay the fee they can most afford in supporting the ministry of Camp Blue Diamond. However, each camper will get the exact same experience regardless of which fee is chosen. Only the camp office personnel will be aware of your choice. If your church pays a part of the fee your choice will not affect their portion of the fee. Churches will also be given the choice of fees.

Please note, for those with greater financial assistance needs, scholarships and other discounts are still available. Visit our website for more details on the tiered pricing, scholarships and other discounts.

Summer Staff, CITs (Counselor In Training) & Vol. Nurses Are Needed

If you, or someone you know, love camp and enjoy kids, working at camp is the greatest! Counselors must be at least 18, committed Christians, enjoy kids, and be able to live in harmony with others. Being a part of camp staff is a great experience. Staff members grow in faith, leadership and communication skills, as well as live in community with other like-minded Christians. For those interested in teaching, ministry or social work (or being a parent), it's terrific on-the- job training! Maintenance & Kitchen staff need to be at least 16, and work 8-hour



days, with time off in the evening to join activities. Pay is \$250 - \$300/week, based on position and experience. Room & board provided. Camp runs June 8 – July 29. Get an application at *campbluediamond.org*. Don't wait too long to apply! We are hiring now!

CIT's are 9th, 10th & 11th graders who help a counselor with a boys' or girls' unit. Being a CIT is a great way to experience counseling. First time CIT's need to attend CIT Camp on June 2 & 3. After completing CIT Camp, you can help with a Junior, Pioneer or Tenderfoot camp. If you attend a youth camp (Youth Camp, Adv. OLS, Yough or Bike Camp) CIT Camp is discounted 50%!

Nurses (RN's, MD's and PA's) are needed for summer camp. Nurses are responsible for administering meds, and treating injured or sick campers.
